Name: Sudia Zulfiger OB=66 Pasagraph Gender disparity is one of the significant issues to education system of Pakistan It leads to lower envollment and higher dropout rate of girls in schools In Global Gender Gap report 2024, Pakistan is ranked at 145th out of 146th countries.

Overall literacy rate in Pakistan is 62:3% among is male iliteracy rate The Net enrollment rate of girls at primary level is 68% and that of boys is 78%. This envollment rate is decreases ut secondary level with 38% girl's eno envolment and 45% of Boys At tertiary level it further decreases to 12.9% of girls and 13.9 of Koys It means that much of the enrollment happens at primary level but according to a report from ASER, there are only 20% primary schools in Pakistan which are located at far distance. People from rural areas are reductant to send their daughters to these distant schools due to the fear of harrassment and violence along the way Moreovers females are not allowed to travel alone due to security issues especially is conflict prone areas of pakistan such as Balochistan, (kpk) Diames Perhawar and Swat. In these areas female teachers and students have long been targetted by

group attacked and burned 20 schools 19 of which were givis schools, in Dians Similarly. In an attack on Army Public School is Peshawas in 2000 in which 140 children essedied, instilled fear among the Students and Parents. These incidents discouraged them their envollment in school Additionally. lack of female staff and poor infrastructure further exacerbated this issue Most of the primary 3 chools lack the availability of even the basic requirements such as sanitary, furniture, electricity and clean drinking water According to ASER, only 42% schools in Pakistan have proper sanitation M these issues directly contributed to the lower female envolment rate in schools. only 29.5% girls complete their primary educations and dropout rate at primary level is 49% At secondary level only 13% girls complete their education. According to UniceF report. 12,2 million girls is Pakistan Jose out- of school. Hence where Pakistan's is grappling with many other issues, gender education system disparity is also one of
