### ① Introduction:

Islam is a complete code of life. It is simple to follow due to its practicality. The concept of Tauheed or belief on one God is the first and essential criteria to be called a muslim. Preaching of the belief on one God was had started from Hazrat Adam (A.S.) and it ended with the last prophet (PBUH). However, every prophet Pye and messenger preached the oneness of Allah, their teachings were limited to a certain region and for a certain time. While, the teachings of Prophet PBUH are all encompassing and will guide the Ummah until the day of judgment. Tauheed has certain impacts on the individuals and society.

## 3) Impact of Tauheed on Individual and Society:

The idea of tauheed and a belief on this idea brings significant changes in the lives of individuals which translates and permeates into the impacts on a whole society.

### a) Impacts of Tauheed on Individual Life:

#### i) It Abolishes narrow mindedness:

A believer on the oneness of Allah is broader in his thinking and outlook. He never restricts himself to one particular thinking and clan. ## b) Impacts of Tauheed on Society
