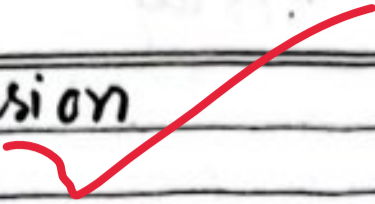

Dhruv Rathi - Indian YouTuber's campaign on social media against BJP caused great damage to the ruling party. In this way, people are engaging in political process through social media.

Similarly, influencing of foreign policy of a country is another prospects of growing power of social media. The common people are actively engaging in national, regional and global affairs through social media platforms. Boycott of Israeli and French products: Pepsi, Nestle, KFC and other products is a case in point in this regard. Punjab government's pre-preparedness for Monsoon season is the result of criticism by public on online platforms. Free Wifi in Lahore, Online Air Ambulance and Federal's provision of free electricity for those using less than 100 units are evident here. There are multiple development projects like Green Line, Metro bus, BRT Peshawar and People's Bus Service that started due to public demand through social media. More significantly, social media promotes online learning and digital education. The world has shifted its focus from traditional learning to online learning. Youtube, Facebook and Zoom are the leading platforms that provide online classes, material and access to online library. Universities are offering online classes to students. EU Disinfo Lab is example here where 700 accounts were found to be used by India against Pakistan. More shockingly, it is an effective tool of cyber attacks. PEGASUS is an Israeli spyware which was used to hack 5000 accounts of politicians, influencers, leaders, and celebrities including Imran Khan. In this way, hybrid war has become more lethal due to growing power of social media.

Shockingly enough, social media is posing an existential threat to democracy. Anti-democratic forces are using it as a tool to harm democracy. Demagogue and populist leaders have done great damage to democracy by promoting their fascist and authoritarian ideology through social media. Capital Hill attacks are evident here. Modi's hindutva policies have proved to be harmful for Muslims and non-Hindus. Freedom of expression and religious freedom and social rights are confiscated and harassed through social media. This makes it threat to democratic values.

Furthermore, the US President said, "The rampant misinformation related to COVID vaccine on social media is killing people."

Quite alarmingly, social media is spreading misinformation and disinformation. It is a tool to spread fake news and propaganda to put harm to others' reputation. Westernization of eastern culture is result of movies of Hollywood, celebrities lifestyle, social media influencers and so on.
