Jodhpur and politics of Accession

Instrument of Accession was not signed by rulers at once. Young Maharaja of Jodhpur held a meeting with Jinnah due to his fear of being kicked out by Socialist Congress Party, in response to his luxurious activities. Considering the geographical proximity towards India, Jinnah still had a hope to get accession of a few princely states. Jinnah gave a blank paper to Maharajah to write his conditions. However, V.P. Menon informed the Viceroy about the tilt of Maharajah towards accession to Pakistan. Viceroy called Jodhpur and advised not to trust in Jinnah. Moreover, the accession to India would be in his favor. Thus, he signed a provincial agreement there.
