The polarization undermines constauctive discourse and leads to the divide among the societies For instance, a Pew Research Center report highlighted the partisan Information on social media has intensified political polasization in the U.S. with 85%. of Damodals and 89% of Republicans perceiving their posties as more divided Than ever Similarly, research by the University of Cambridge Showed that misinformation during the Brexit Referendum hightened political divisions in the U.K Thus,

managing viewpoints responsibly is the Key to mitigate political polarization.

The legal and ethical challenges surrounding free speech necessistates a balanced approach. Johnse freedom of expression is a Fundamental right, I must be regulated to prevent hagm. The European Court of Human Rights has ruled that restrictions on speech are permissible when they protect against hate speech and inatement to viderce. Charles Schenck, a socialist distributed antiwar pamphlets, claiming the deaft was unconstitutional.
