2 Elections 1937 in India:

Under The Government of India Act 1935, elections were held in India.

The top two political parties, Congress and Muslim League also participated but the result was beyond their high expectations.

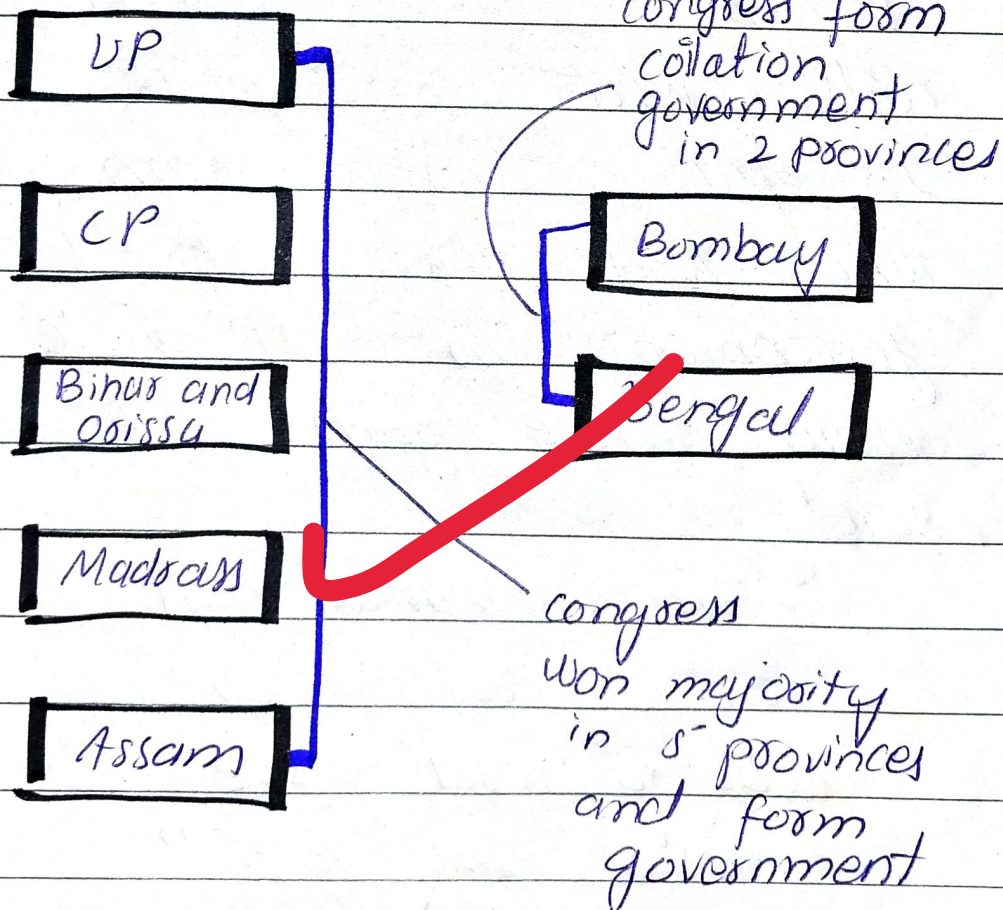

4, Congress rule in India and its atrocities

As congress had form the government in eight provinces but its atrocities on the Muslims were uncountable.

(A) Communal Riots:

Under congress rule in India during the period, 1937-39, the communal riots were on peak.

In fact Yeast Brown who was the part of government in UP wrote about these riots. He said:

"The communal riots were trippled in UP, robbery cases were increased by 70%."

(B) Bande Mataram Song:

(C) Wardha Scheme:

This scheme was also against the sentiments of Muslims. In such scheme Muslims were taught about the heroes of Hindus and were asked to praise them.

(D) Vidiya Mandar Scheme:

These was another scheme to humiliate the Muslims that was Vidiya Mandar Scheme.

In that Scheme

Muslims were asked to bow before the picture of Ghandi

(E) Hositing three coloured flag:

Hindus set their flag with British flag to show that there are just two nations in India - The Britishers and The Hindus.

(F) Banned cow slaughtering:

Hindus under the congress

rule showed their real face. They had put bars on cow slaughtering. Just to serve their interest and sentiments they ruined the sentiments of Muslims.

I. H. Qureshi rightly said: "The congress rule is not the rule, it is the oligarchy of Congress in India"

(G) Azan was prohibited,

Azan was prohibited in those provinces where the congress was in power. Pigs were pushed into mosques where the Muslims were offering prayers.

(H) Replacement of Urdu with Hindi:

Congress did its utmost effort to replace Urdu with Hindi language. Many historians wrote that Urdu was the first brick in the foundation of Pakistan.
