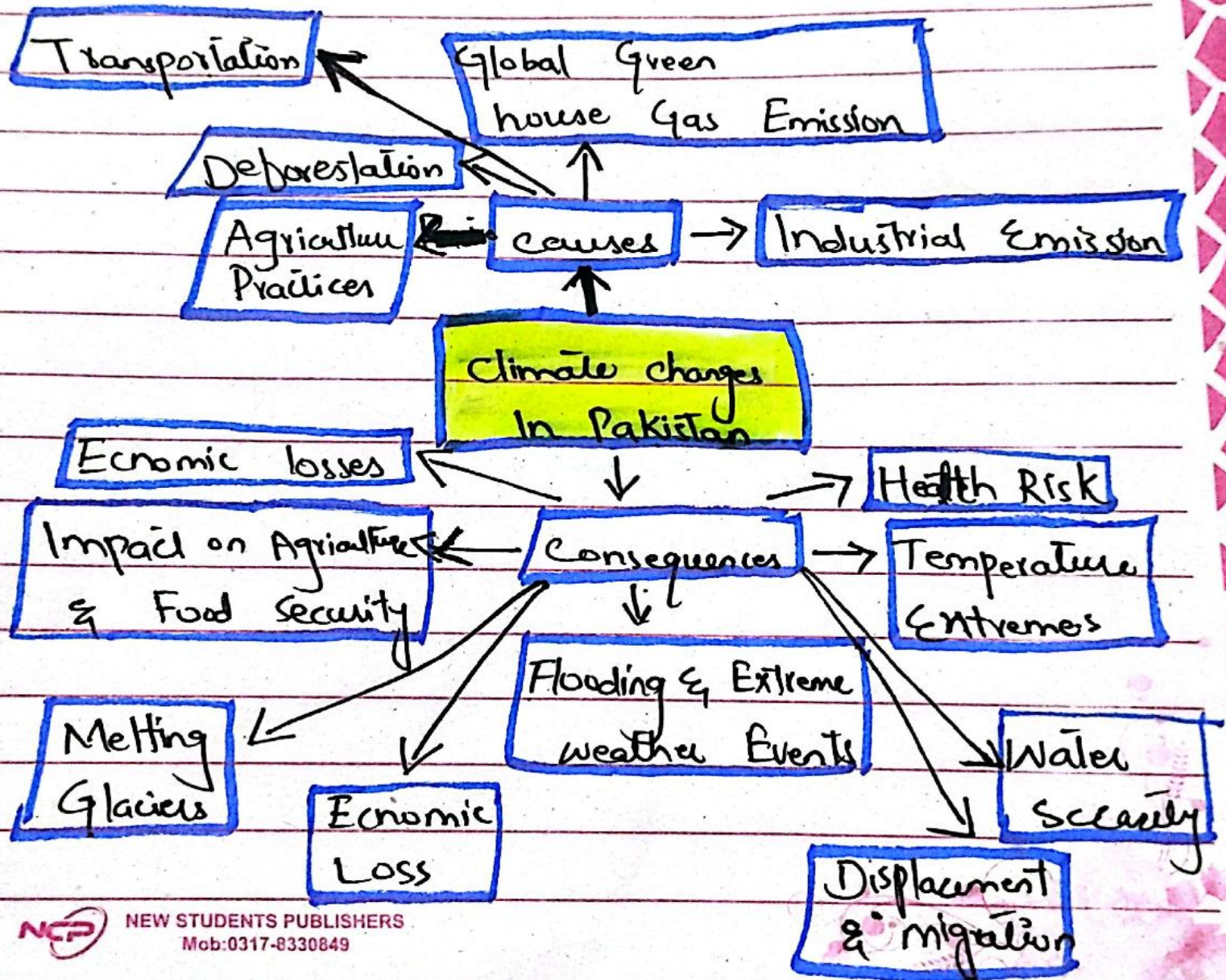

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The Essay

In 2022, One-Third of Pakistan was submerged under floodwaters, affecting over 33 million people and causing economic losses exceeding \$30 billion. Ironically, Pakistan contributes less than 1% to global carbon emission, yet remains among the top ten countries most vulnerable to climate change. This ultimate paradox highlights the disproportionate burden borne by a developing nation in crisis driven largely by global industrial activity. Within Pakistan, local factors such as deforestation, unregulated urbanization and outdated agricultural practices have only intensified the situation. As temperature rises, glaciers melt, and rainfall patterns become erratic, the consequences reverberate through every sector from agriculture and public health to national security.



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
