(Case in point: Instructing or correcting a teenager with non-punitive style, when he/she commits a mistake)

3C) Youth ^{on getting} imposed to academia, it fortifies the skills and talent base with the instructions of mentors.

(Case in point: Career counselling sessions nurture the minds and prove to be the ^{career} guide)

3D) With the ever-learning and ever-growing minds, a youth learns much through the life lessons of others, being instructed or taught.

(Case in point: the life experiences of hardships and hardwork of the great men, shape the personalities)

4) Is it necessary that ^{the} instructions always get fixed in their minds, like an engraved stone?

4A) Harsh or forcible way of instructing the youth can make them rebellious.

(Bangladesh's revolution as youth movement emerged)

4B) Visual instructing method is far more productive than verbal instructing method

(Case in point: The teaching methods of public and private schools, are validated by the levels of productivity)

4C) Mutual understanding and context based instruction base proves to be more efficient

(Case in point: Psychiatrist leaves ^{the} lasting impression by getting in someone else's shoes)
