Eid-ul-Fitr

On 1st Shawal according to Islamic calendar muslims celebrate eid-ul-fitr. On this day muslims wears new clothes and shoes and start the day with eid prayer. Eid is the great festival among muslims they celebrate only two eids in a year. Second day of Eid is usually not much interesting as the first day of Eid.

On third day of Eid people also celebrates Eid but the colors of Eid fades on the evening of third day because holidays get end and everyone start preparation for their normal routine.
