Climate change can generally be defined as a change in global or regional climate pattern. The Framework Convention on climate (UNFCCC), in its Article 1, defines climate change as: "A change of climate which is attributed directly or indirectly to human activity that alters the composition of the global atmosphere and which is in addition to natural climate variability observed over comparable time periods". Pakistan ranks among the top 10 countries world wide most affected by climate change. Unfortunately, there are some

factors which Causes climate changes in pakistan, are Green house gases, natural Disasters, Deforestation, Floods, Drought and industrialization leading to Rising temperature and weather changes, water scarcity and food shortage and economic losses.
