Global warming is an anthropogenic driven phenomenon. It is a scientifically proven reality which has significant impacts. The concentration of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere is increasing mainly due to the human activities. As of 2024, earth's temperature has risen by approximately 1.2°C above the pre-industrial level, according ~~IPPC's sixth assessment Report~~. transition. They argue that global warming is a natural process and humans are being deceived by the scientific community but there is clear evidence that the current warming is driven by anthropogenic activities and is posing an alarming situation for the future.

The concentration of carbon dioxide is increasing in the atmosphere due to human activities. Human activities such as deforestation, transportation, urbanization, etc are introducing abnormal levels of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere. This increased concentration of carbon dioxide traps more heat in the atmosphere and prevent it from escaping, thereby contributing to the global warming.

According to the **World Meteorological Organization (WMO)**, the concentration of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere is **41.6 billion tonnes in 2024** mainly driven by the land use change and use of fossil fuels. Increased levels of CO₂, mainly due to deforestation, fossil fuel consumption is boiling the earth. Now, the world has crossed the threshold of global warming and is moving towards global boiling. The World Meteorological Organization has declared 2024 as the warmest year on the record~~, based on six international data sets. The past ten years ^{have} all been in top ten, in an extraordinary streak of record breaking temperatures. These ~~rising~~ temperatures due to human activities is making more of the planet uninhabitable.

The unprecedented hike in temperature is making more of the planet not ideal to sustain life (Due to increasing temperature and humidity, human physiology is unable to adapt). Physiologically, human beings are not fit to survive this elevated temperature.

As a result, people migrate and live in extreme conditions to continue their survival. Around 600 million people are living outside the habitable climatic conditions, and with each degree of future warming, an estimated 10% of global population will join them. South Africa and Persian Gulf are already experiencing deadly heat as the world approaches 1.5°C of warming. Therefore, rising temperature is turning more of the planet uninhabitable.

The increased consumption of fossil fuels by human beings is also one of the main drivers of global warming. As there is more consumption of fossil fuels, resultantly there is an increased amount of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere. This elevated level of greenhouse gases trap the heat from the sun and, therefore,

increase the temperature of earth. According to the ~~National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)~~, the atmospheric carbon dioxide concentration has reached ~~421 parts per million (ppm) in 2024~~, the highest level in at least 3 million years. And most of it because of the consumption of fossil fuels. This rising levels of greenhouse gases due to fossil fuel consumption is causing unprecedented increase in temperature and increase in climate variability.

Global warming is leading to the increased climate variability. Global warming is being increasingly observed.

Unpredictable and extreme weather patterns are happening due to the climate change. According to the ~~WMO~~ Secretary General, Celeste Saulo, "as a result of rising temperatures, the hydrological cycle has accelerated. It has also become more erratic and unpredictable, and we are facing growing problems of either too much or

too little water. A warmer atmosphere holds more moisture which is conducive to heavy rainfall." Therefore, global warming has become a chain reaction in which one disaster leads to another yet there are some critiques who deny this part and all its consequences. According to them global warming is a deception and a natural cycle.

Critiques argue that carbon dioxide is not the main driver of global warming. They claim that natural factors such as solar cycles, water vapor, dominate climate change. According to this argument, the levels of carbon dioxide rises lag temperature increases and not the other way round. According to a research paper of 2020, 'The phase relation between carbon dioxide and temperature', carbon dioxide lags temperature in glacial cycle, reflecting a feedback mechanism ie warming oceans release carbon dioxide. This shows that carbon dioxide

~~Critics claim that climate models overpredict warming. This shows data manipulation to create a false perception of the actual reality. The satellite Temperature Data analysis by university of Alabama, shows a warming trend of 0.13°C per decade, while models predicted 0.2°C per decade.~~

~~Critiques allege that the climate research is funded to push political and financial agendas. Different countries are funding the research to preach~~

their distorted narratives about climate change and its consequences. The United States government spent 13.6 billion on climate science from 2018 to 2023.

Skeptics claim that this creates bias and helps them to achieve their political agendas. By funding ~~support~~ research, they're forcing pre-determined conclusion upon common people and making a way towards renewable energy.

The cutaques argue that transition towards renewable energy is in fact a money making scheme. By highlighting the distressing false scenarios of the global warming, big companies and developed nations are trying to fill their pockets. The green policies enrich corporations and politicians. The global renewable energy market grew to 1.3 trillion dollars in 2022, according to the renewable energy market outlook, 2023. Therefore, these big corporations and politicians represent global warming as

a terrifying reality to economically benefit from it.

Historical climate variability also disapproves that the rising temperatures are due to the human impacts. It has been claimed by some people that human activities are not the main drivers of climate change. Over 99% of climate scientists agree that human activities, such as burning fossil fuels are the main cause of global warming since the 1900s. Different regions are facing intense and unparalleled disasters due to it.

In 2023, Canada faced its worst wildfire season, burning over 45 million acres, linked to hotter, drier conditions. These events also align with climate models predicting more extreme weather. The scientific community is united on this front and regard it as an ultimate reality.
