

— Should Pak resume trade with India.

Pakistan imports raw material for pharma & textile industries, many agricultural products and exports salt, sulphur, leather, cement, fruits. Pakistan imports more than exports. In 2018 India exported \$1.8 billion worth of goods and, while Pakistan exported only \$500 million worth of goods to India. This unfair bilateral trade caused trade deficit in Pakistan, affecting economy.

In 2019 after Pulwama Attack and revocation of Article 370, trade has come to halt between two countries. Pakistan refused to trade until the reversal of
↓ Article 370 is reversed by India.

Due to high inflation Pakistan's economy is facing challenges, importing goods from India can benefit Pakistani consumer as they are cheaper. Countries worldwide trade despite of having tensions, China and India trade, similarly UAE and Israel trade. Pakistan can offer to resume limited trade until the reversal of Article 370 to help economy while still ^{maintaining} standing ~~on~~ its moral stance on Kashmir.

To deal with public resentment, government should communicate to public that this is not surrender but a tool to help economy.
