

can exercise the characteristics he possess as one can't inherent these qualities and everything that he does, no one can do it. It compromises faith, worship, social functions and rituals.

Shibli Nomani in his book Seret-un-Nabi noted that: 'Islam is like a fort and the gate of fort is Toheed'

Toheed guides that there is no God in the universe other than Allah, Surah-Al-Akhdas highlights that: 'Say Allah is the one; He is the eternal refuge; He neither begets nor is born; Nor is there to him any equivalent'

2) Risalat (The belief in prophethood): Risalat is the second part of Kalimah. This concept is interlinked with Oneness of God. It means that a person must have faith on all the prophets that God has sent in all the region of the world. Quran also testifies the concept of Risalat. Allah in Surah-al-Nabi expresses that: And verily we have sent among every ummah a prophet (proclaiming worship Allah and don't worship taghut beside Allah).

The life^{lives} of prophets^{are} : guidelines for us that guide us how to spend our lives, In Quran (Al-Azhar) Allah says: "The life of Holy prophet (S.A.W) is complete conduct of life"

3) Dignity of Mankind: Islam raised the dignity of mankind and brought paradigm shift from the time where humans were bearing no respect, there were discrimination among people. Greek and Persian societies used to respect those who had power. Women were treated badly, but

their dignity, without any discrimination. In Surah Bani Israel, Allah says: "Certainly we have honoured the children of Adams"

4) Islam as a complete Code of Conduct: Islam guides mankind in every aspect of its life. It guides an individual from the birth to upbringing to his character building to his education and finally to his family life. Islam teaches an individual how to spend the life from his birth to the death and this circle continues from generation to next generation. Along with it, Islam acts as a complete guide for collective life. It gives us rules and regulations to attain peace, prosperity and development by implementing and devising social, judicial, financial and political system.

⑤ Islam Promotes humanity: Islam is not only a guide of human life but also acts as an instructor that promotes humanity, affections, care and welfare in the society. Islam guides human to deliver the rights of people to them. It ^{does} not only help to promote peace but to adopt character that would make a person responsible to take care of rights of living things as well as non living things. Holy prophet (S.A.W) once said: "The perfect among those who are best in their character."

Islam makes a person responsible so he takes a great care of his surrounding and the people living near to him with peace, harmony and attention.

6) Promotion of Equality: Islam is a peaceful religion which negates all the ideas of superiority on the basis of wealth or name. Before Islam the society was divided into different classes on the basis of wealth, ethnicity and creed but Islam refuted all these concepts. To Islam all human beings are equal no matter who possesses more wealth or has fair color. Holy prophet asserted this on Farewell Sermon, "All of you are equal; no one of you has any superiority on other; not a Arab has any superiority over non Arab or vice versa but on the basis of Piety."

(7) Protection of Human Rights: Islam is the one of the great religion which advocates human rights. In other religions humans are being sacrificed to attain God but Islam despite of assuming human life a valueless gives values to human life and advocates the fulfillment of human rights. Holy prophet in his last sermon has ascribed the rights of all Individual including neighbours, spouse, parents and even non Muslim. He (S.A.W) asserted "That God command justice, compassion and giving their due to their relatives"

Islam also advocates about the right of women who were being treated odd in previous religions. He (S.A.W) said: O people fear Allah concerning women, you have taken them with the security of Allah.

8) Accountability and Justice: one of the most notable feature of Islam is accountability and justice.

Islam promotes justice, Islam denotes a judicial system which acts according to Shariat of Islam. The life of Holy prophet Himself is a light of justice when a woman from a well reputed tribe has committed a crime to steal something, Many Ahsab have insisted Holy prophet to forgive that woman by the response of all those request Holy prophet said "If there would have been Fatma - Binte - Muhammad, I would have given the same order to cut off her hands. So Islam promotes justice, as Allah advocated and advised humanity to carry justice in Surah - Al-Baqarah:

" And don't mixup the truth with falsehoods nor hide the truth while you know"

Conclusion: Islam is multidimensional religion which promotes mutual cooperation, peace, equality and enforces law and order. It is not only the code of conduct for Muslims or any class but holds some guidance and lesson for whole the humanity without any discrimination.
