Firstly, diplomacy is the cornerstone of peacebuilding, enabling nations to resolve the disputes through dialogue rather than conflict. By facilitating the negotiations, diplomats creates pathways to de-escalation and reconciliation. A prime example is 2015 Iran Nuclear deal, where P5 nation (US, UK, Russia, France, china) negotiated with Iran to curb its nuclear

program in exchange for sanction relief. This agreement later demonstrated the diplomacy's ability to address high stakes security concerns without resorting to military actions. Through platforms like the United Nations, diplomatic efforts in peacekeeping talks further stabilize volatile regions, fostering trust and the long term peace.

Secondly, diplomacy drives economic co-operation, strengthening prosperity through trade agreements and the partnerships. By negotiating deals that open the market and encourage investments, diplomats reduce economic tensions and promote mutual growth. The 2020 Abraham Accords, facilitated by US diplomacy, normalize relations between Israel and UAE, leading new trade route and economic collaboration in middle east. Also, multilateral agreements like the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP) in 2020 highlights how diplomacy aligns diverse economies for shared benefits. Such economic interdependence discourage conflict and nation prioritize prosperity over rivalry.

Thirdly, diplomacy plays a critical role in preventing the conflicts by addressing tensions before they escalate. Through engagements like summits and background talks, diplomats mitigate risk of the miscalculation. The 1998 Lahore Summit between India and Pakistan also known as the "Bus diplomacy" initiative, was a significant attempt to improve

relations between the two countries. Organizations like the organization for security and co-operation in Europe (OSCE) further exemplify this by monitoring regional flash point and mitigate the disputes. Diplomacy ensure stability in high stake environment.

Similarly, diplomacy foster cultural exchange and soft power, building good will and understanding between nations. Through initiatives like cultural exchange, educational programs, nations enhance their global influence. ~~Erasmus~~ US Fulbright program and UGRAD are the notable examples, promoting languages, culture and education to bridge divide. By strengthening people to people ties, cultural diplomacy creates a foundation for the co-operative international relations.

As diplomacy strengthens global governance by enabling collective actions through international institutions. Challenges like climate change and pandemics require co-ordinated responses, which is facilitated by diplomacy.
