### Manto's Writings: Portraying Social Realities

**Precis:** Manto was condemned because of his writings. He exposed social hypocrisy, with critics labelling his work as vulgar and immoral, leading to a legal battle. Despite backlash, he remained committed to truthfully depicting the harsh realities of life; which many conservative

critics found offensive. Following Freud's thoughts, he tried to explore sexuality with realism showing empathy for marginalized groups like wage-earners and prostitutes. For Manto, man is a mix of good and evil. He showed middle and lower-middle class as real people and dealt with important social issues. As a realist, he was aware of ~~social~~ <sup>repetition of same idea</sup> ~~background~~ appearance and ~~display~~ <sup>display</sup> dual behaviors across different classes of society. He addressed vulgarity skillfully without even appealing vulgar himself. Like other renowned writers wrote Manto's works reflected universal restlessness.
