- 1 Improve access to affordable and regulated rehabilitation centers.
 - 1.1 - Only 108 rehabilitation centers exist nationwide, most of them in major cities (ANF Report 2023).
 - 1.2 - WHO standards recommend 1 rehab center per 100,000 population - Pakistan has 1 per 2 million.
