of any human being.

them good things."

Not only are human rights based on the  
fundamental idea of human dignity but  
all of the tenets of the divine religions  
support it as well. In Islam every person  
has the same dignity, regardless of gender, caste  
and creed.

Islam arrived with the message of equality without regard to social class, age, race or colour centuries before contemporary theories of human dignity were developed.

Surah Al-Hujrat 13

O people, indeed, we created you from male & female and made you people and tribes so that you know one another. Indeed the most honorable of you in the sight of Allah is the most righteous of you."

Creator of Universe commanded humanity not to be suspicious of anyone, even slaves, nor to pry into their personal affairs. Allah gave the order to refrain from disparaging them or engaging in backbiting to harm their reputation. Allah compare this to eating the flesh of one's deceased brother.

Islam strongly emphasizes humanity, the thing that unites all the people and human dignity. Nevertheless the angels are informed that there will be created beings who will serve as Vicegerents on earth



and be accorded honour.

Surah Isra 17:70

"We have certainly honoured the children of adam and carried them on land and sea and provided for them of the good things we preferred them over much of what we have created with preference."

Respect the children of adam include all the universe along with minorities and their right. When Hazrat Umar took over as caliph, the Christians complained to him about al-walid's forcible occupation of church land. Hazrat Umar ordered the official to get that part of mosque demolished which had been constructed on the land of church and return it to Christians."

Bukhari

Quran 17:35

"Give full measure when you measure, and weight with an even balance. That is the best (way) and best in result."

Whereas Islam have also some strick instruction for condemnation of bribery as this is an another evil for which the world today have laid down and regulations is bribery.

Quran (2:188)

"And do not consume one anothers wealth unjustly or send it (in bribery) to the ruler in order that (they might aid) you



to consume a portion of the wealth of the people in sin, while you know (it is unlawful).

Quran (42:40)
