to damage the other country

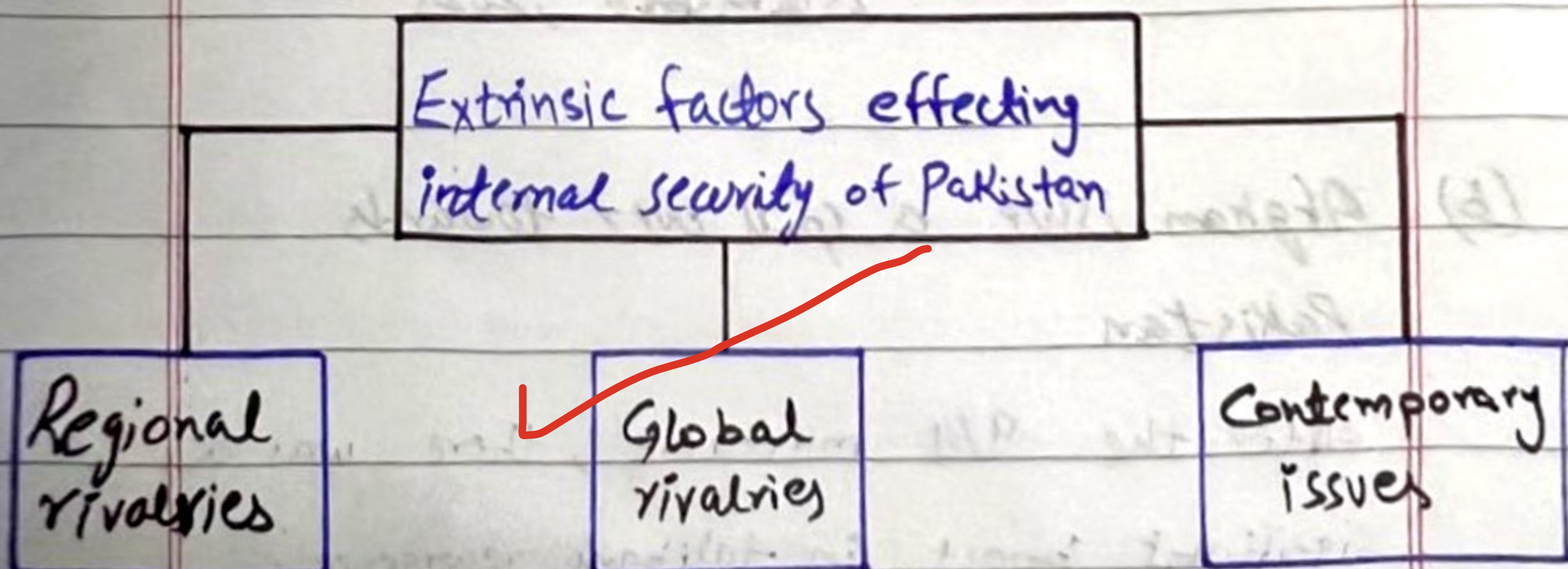

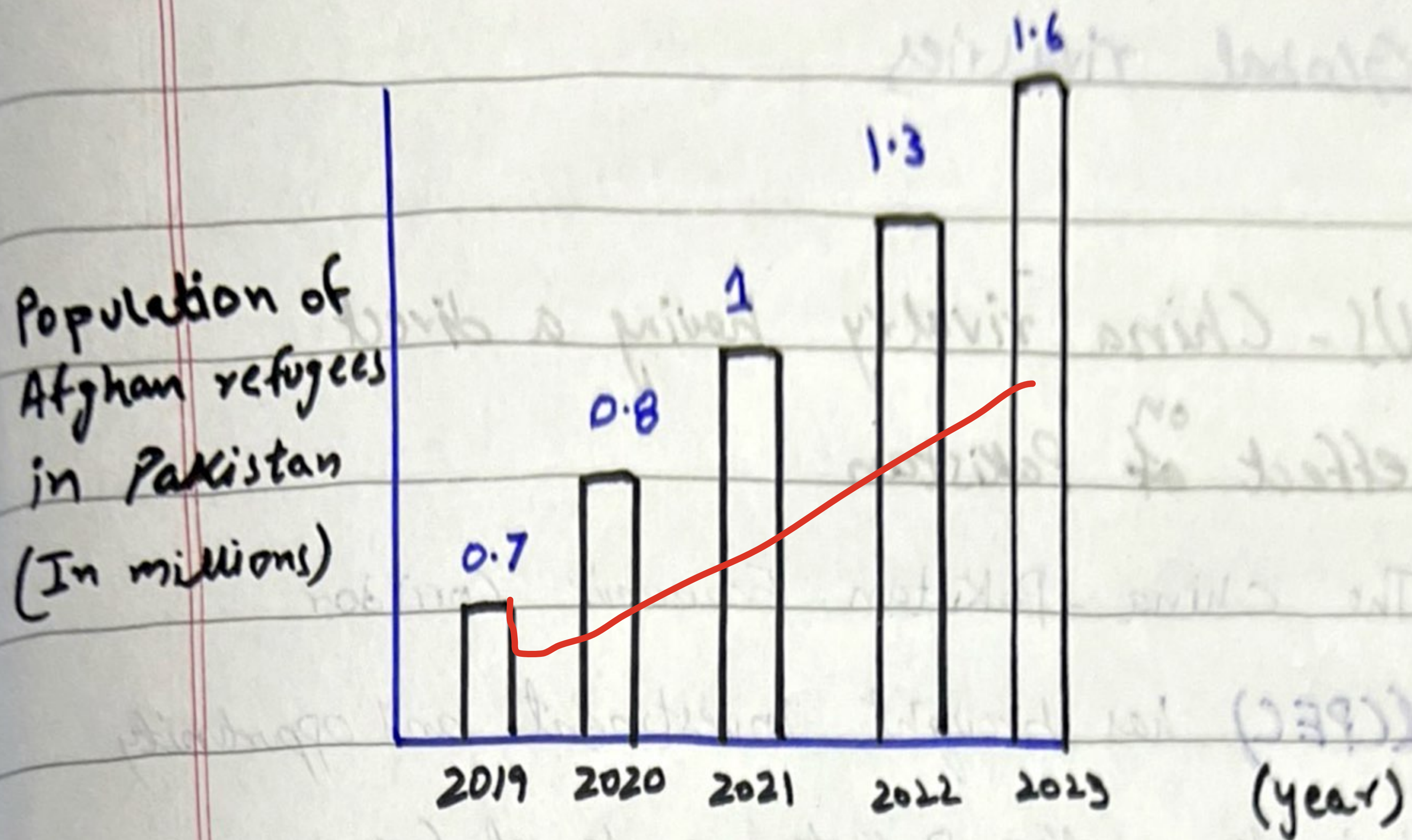
(b) Afghan issue a spill over towards Pakistan
