In recent decades, industrial emissions, deforestation, andreckless resource exploitation have disrupted the planet's climate system. The intergovernmental panel on climate change (IPCC) reports a 1.1°C rise in global temperatures since pre-industrial times, triggering severe consequences: melting glaciers, rising seas, destructive floods, prolonged droughts, and extreme weather events. What was once a gradual natural phenomenon has transformed into a fast-moving, human-driven, crises with planetary implications.
