4. Key member's divergent agendas

China is using SCO platform to promote BRI and counter US presence in the region. Russia is trying to break post-Ukraine isolation. Iran is sanctioned state and joining SCO member to create nuclear weapons. Pakistan is looking for alternative alliance after ~~USA~~ USA ~~there~~ silence stance on Kashmir issue. India want to create balance with U.S. and SCO member states.

5. Limitations to Anti-western unity

There is no mutual defense ~~clause~~ ^{clause} unlike NATO. Charter avoids collective security of its member countries. There have been ~~state~~ conflict between India and Pakistan, over water dispute, Kashmir and terrorism which can weaken the SCO ~~from~~ ^{from} its main objective. Moreover, Kazakh oil fields use US and EU technology. ~~there~~ Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan are heavy U.S. ~~bases~~ ^{bases} and EU is the Kazakhstan's number 1 trade partner of amount \$48 billion. So, are the reasons which create limitation to Anti-western unity.

Strategic Utility: A "Soft" Anti-Western Bloc

SCO promotes multipolarity and Asian values which provide alternatives to western liberal hegemonic ~~internationalism~~ internationalism. SCO encourages and supports local currency trade and alternative payment systems to reduce reliance on the U.S. dollar and SWIFT. It provides Iran a platform to build diplomatic alternatives and western sanctions amid ~~US~~ Israel and Iran war. Still, SCO is not a formal anti-western alliance. ~~As~~ As it represents a ~~coalition~~ coalition of convenience for seeking strategic autonomy, regional influence and multipolar diplomacy.
