Answer:

Introduction:

The growing relation between Russia and China holds a unique significance in the global dynamics. Both countries having same vision are growing ties in military, economic, cultural and technological fields. This increasing bond plays an essential role to counter Western bloc. However, these two countries have not publicly supported each other. The impact of this new block has influenced the western sanctions, dollars dependency and multipolar world. Thus, the increasing ties between Russia and China remain a central point in dynamics of global power.

Key factors determining growing relation between Russia and China:

Frustration with the U.S led system:

Both the countries believe that U.S led system favours west than the global south.
Sovereignty issues:

Both China and Russia are more concern of their sovereignty. They don't want the U.S interference in Taiwan and Russia disintegrated neighbours.

Critical evaluation of growing ties between two emerging powers:

In 2021, both countries celebrated twenty years of neighborhoodness. Their growing ties results to counter the effect of global north and to reap maximum benefit from their relation.

1- Energy pipeline: to China - new market for Russia:

After Ukraine, Russia's invasion of Ukraine, the U.S imposed sanctions on

Russia and the Europe also cut ties.
Then Russia started to sell its energy to China. Russia got new market while China had opportunity to buy in lower price. Thus, new energy plan power of Siberia II is also planned.

2 - Military support to China - Strengthening military ties to suppress U.S power
About 40% of military weapons are being purchased from Russia.
It provides mutual benefit to both states.

3 - Economic ties and trade - Use of local currency to reduce dependency on dollars.

In 2022, trade between two countries was \$200B which increased to \$245B in 2024. More of the trade is done in Yuan.

4 - Technology transfer to Russia -
A step toward digitalization to curb the western dominance.

say "junior" of China.

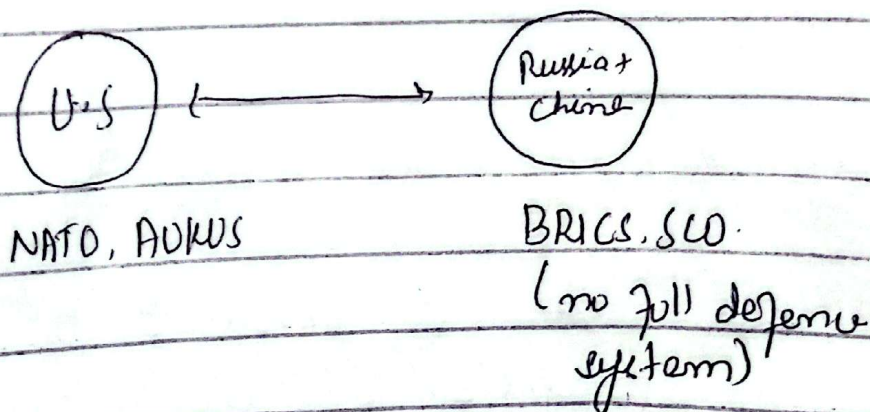
2- China's fear of West:
