Additionally, by solving the hygiene issues on campus would greatly impact the input of the students. Placing cafeteria's next to washrooms or

allowing animals inside these cafés sets a bad precedent and could lead to ^{the} students getting sick. Taking serious steps towards improve^{ing} hygiene issue and completely solving it would create a safe-environment for the student body. Therefore, allocating budget to improve infrastructure is ^a necessary remedy for higher education in Pakistan.

The third remedy for higher education ⁱⁿ ~~of~~ Pakistan is providing students with affordable education. Student support programs have been a cornerstone for many universities in the West. Universities in Pakistan should promote student support programs that would empower less privileged students. This allows students from various parts Pakistan to compete with one another at an equal footing. Similarly, the higher educational institutes in Pakistan should announce more scholarships.
