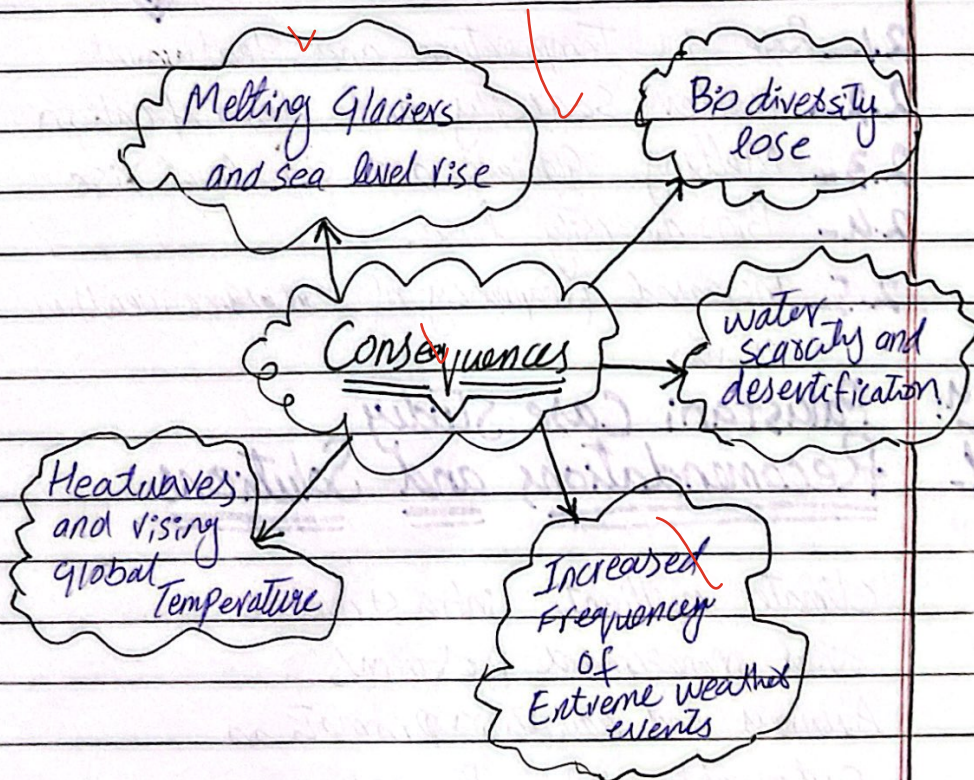
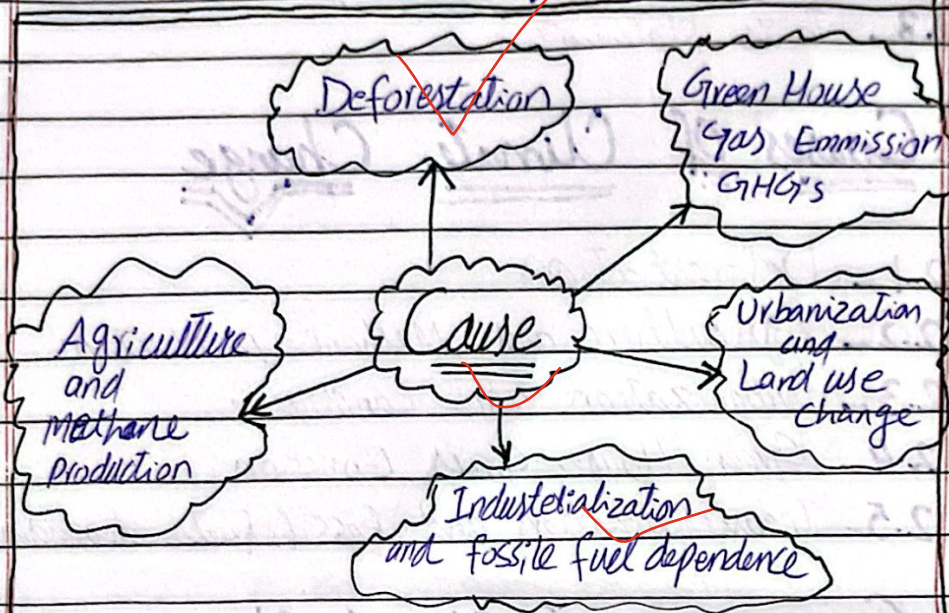

To begin with deforestation, that is the tree cutting process of people on earth is the major causes of climate change IPCC, Intergovernmental Panel of climate change reported that more than 10 million hectares between 2015 to 2020. massive deforestation cause the rise of Carbon dioxide in atmosphere. According to the National Oceanic And Atmospheric Authority, (NOAA), the level of Carbon dioxide has increased in the atmosphere with 424 ppm. Trees act as an carbon sink.
