### 1- Family - 1<sup>st</sup> stage

This was the first institution in the history of man. Family is consisted of spouses and their childrens. The concept of sovereign was also present in families either matriarchal or patriarchal. The theory of how lead one stage to the next stage and ultimately modern - nation - state.

### 2- Clan - 2<sup>nd</sup> stage

These city states were established back in 1000 BC. These city states were famous for different attributes as Greece.

## 5. Empires

Empires have huge territory and huge population. They are biggest in all stages till modern states. The most famous is Roman empire. Empires also have a sovereign and their boundaries were not fixed. Last Empire was ended after WW II. In treaty of Westphalia, one nation can have one state.

## 6- Modern nation - state

Modern nation-states are more independent and well established. These are broken pieces of empires. Modern nation-states have big population but fixed borders. The boundaries are fixed and can not be expanded unilaterally. The sovereignty is associated to general public in west. Modern nations respect each other and build bilateral relations.

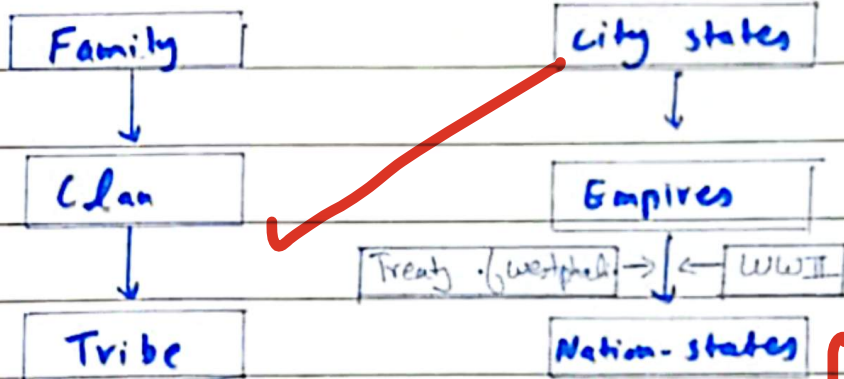
## ⇒ Violation of modern nation-state
