QNO: 2 Discuss in detail the advent of British impact in USA?

Introduction: "America is the nation of nations" - Obama. The advent of Britishers in the USA was due to several reasons such as: finding of new trade route, Advancement in Technology, collision of King and Pope, Religious Persecution, Political Persecution, Poor Agriculture of Europe, Imperialism, Rising population of Europe, already existed tribes in the US, Ambitious explorers for new discoveries, and for private ownership which was denied for protestants in the Europe.

The Impact of British in the advent of USA:

There are different impacts of Britishers on the advent of USA; few are:

- (i) Finding of new trade route by Christopher Columbus sponsored by King Ferdinand:

King Ferdinand and Queen Isabella of Spain had sponsored Christopher Columbus for the finding of new trade route.

Later, Amerigo Vespucci named the "new world", "strange world"

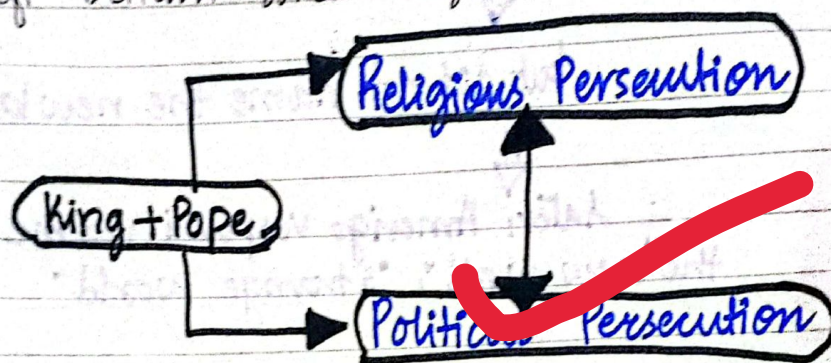
A new land was discovered by the name of America. Later, different colonizations were settled in the land of America and colonized different parts of America.

(ii) Advancement in Technology:
Press Revolution by Johannes Gutenberg in 1440.

In 1440, Johannes Gutenberg started making efforts for press revolution. Because at that time books were only the authority of Queen, kings and popes. Common people have not access of books. Therefore, Johannes Gutenberg started press revolution.

(iii) Collision of King and Pope in the Ownership of King's authority:

King and pope both were divesting human beings that King is the divine authority. This has escalated religious persecution and political persecution. Therefore many of the individuals left Britain and migrated to the new land.



(iv) Religious Persecution:

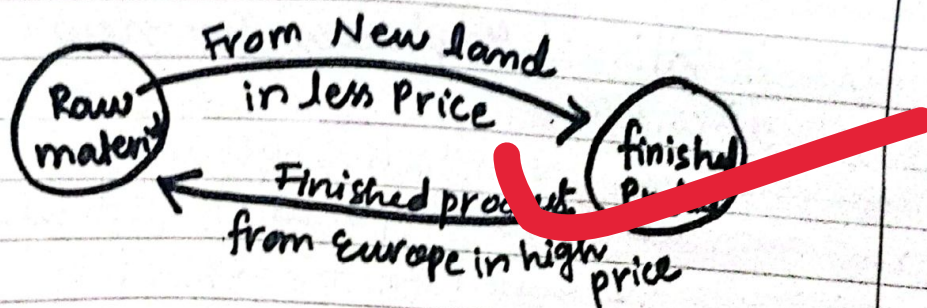

(v) Political Persecution:

(vii) Increase population of Europe around 100 million:

There were four tribes that already existed on the land of strange world.

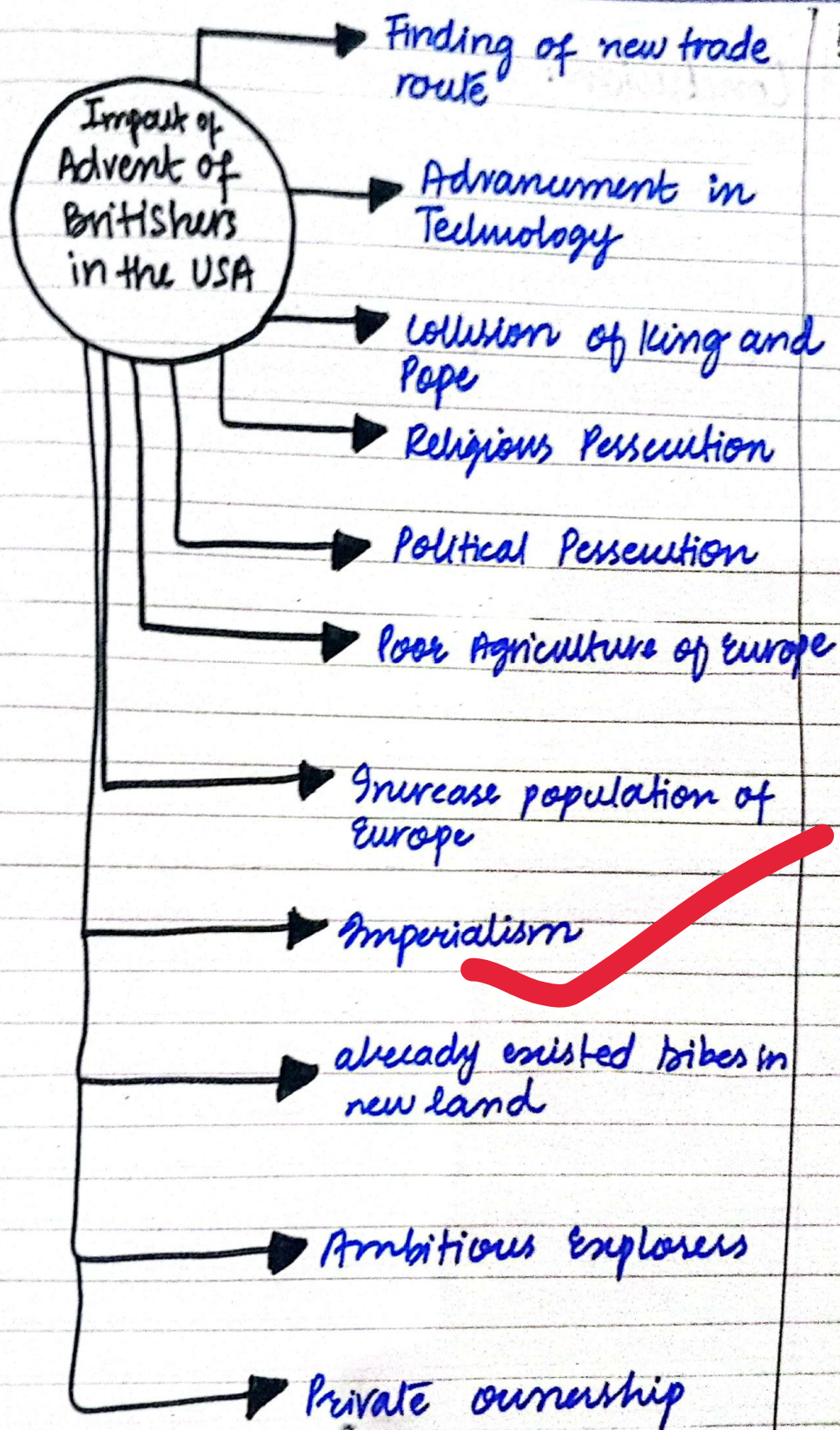


(X) Ambitious explorers for new discoveries:
