There are several spiritual, social, moral, economic and community benefits of Hajj.

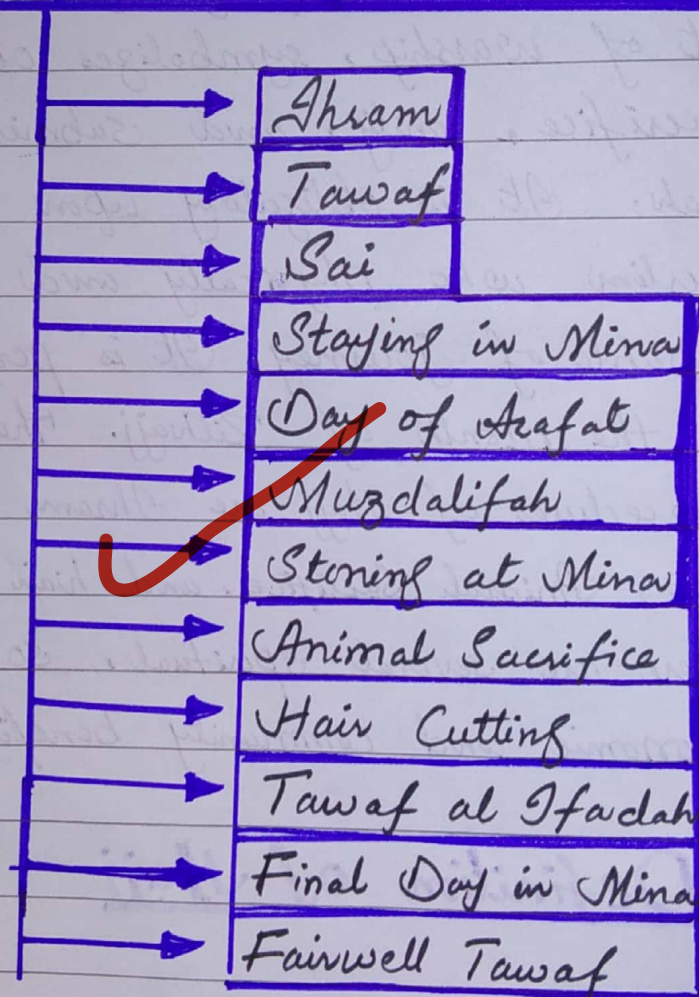
Definition of Hajj

The term Hajj means pilgrimage, pilgrimage to Mecca, Saudi Arabia. Its literal meaning is to intend a journey.

Hajj is the pillar of Islam. It should be performed by every muslim once in

life time. It is performed in the month of Zilhajj. It is an act of worship in Islam which symbolizes obedience, sacrifice, unity and submission to Allah. It creates brotherhood, equality and global identity of Muslims.

Simple Procedures Of Hajj

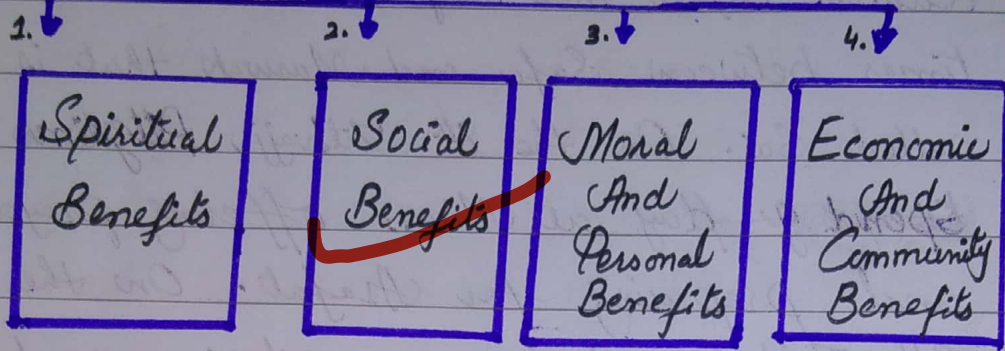


Leaving home the pilgrims have to wear Ihram (a dress of two white pieces of cloth) at Meezgat (a place near Mecca). Reaching Mecca / Makkah they

keep the description of a single argument brief and attempt by giving subheadings....

will make Tawaf Seven times round the Kaaba. After that they will run seven times between Safa and Marwah that is called Sai. On the 8th Zilhajj, Pilgrims spend ~~9~~ day at Mina, offering prayers, and preparing for Arafat. On the 9th Zilhajj, before noon pilgrims reach at Arafat and listening^{to} Sermon. After sunset pilgrims go to Muzdalifah, where they offer Maghrib and Isha prayer and ~~stay~~ spend night there. After that pilgrims throw stones at Jamrat al Aqabah, symbolizing the rejection of Satan. Then they sacrifice animal, remembering the sacrifice of Hazrat Ibrahim (A.S). After sacrifice, men cut their hair, women cut small portion of hair. Then perform another Tawaf around the Kaaba, completing rites of Hajj. Pilgrims ~~throw~~ stones at three pillars for two to three days on 11th and 12th or 13th Zilhajj. In the last pilgrims perform farewell Tawaf around the Kaaba (Tawaf ul Wada).
