The western nationalist of Ukraine pressurized the president to integrate with the Europe and the Russian speaking people of eastern Ukraine wanted to join Russia.

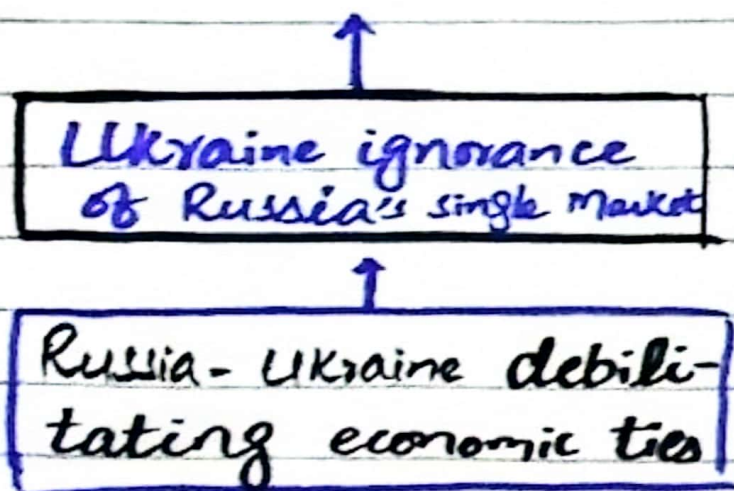
