## Introduction

The word Islam has its roots in Arabic language. It is derived from an Arabic word "SLM" which means "to surrender", "to submit", "to yield", "to give one's self up" and other meaning of Islam is "peace". Imam Raghib al-Isfahani in his book "al-mafadat fi Ghataib al-Qur'an", divided Islam into two kinds, one is simple confession with tawhid and other is that along with confession it's practice in daily life. He further says, "Islam" means entering into peace. Syed Ameen Ali in his famous book "the spirit of Islam" defines Islam as, in its primary sense means peace and in secondary sense means, to

## Contextual meaning of Islam

## Salient features of Islam

Following are some basic characteristics of Islam.

### ① Simplicity, Rationalism and Practicalism

Islam is a religion without any mythology. The teachings of Islam are very simple and free from any irrational beliefs. The "Tawheed", "Prophethood" and "the day of judgement" are the basic articles of Islam. All are based on sound logic. All basic teachings of Islam are derived or followed from these articles of belief and are simple and straightforward. There is no concept of hierarchy of priests, no complicated rites and rituals. ### ② Complete way of life

Islam is a religion which is not only limited to the personal or individual life but it is a complete code of life. It provide guidance regarding every aspect of

### ③ Universality and Humanism

### ④ Permanence and change

The elements of permanence and change coexist in human society and culture and are bound to remain so. Too much emphasis on permanence makes the system rigid

and robs it of flexibility and progress, while of lack of permanent values and unchanging elements generate moral relativism, shapelessness. The Quran and Sunnah contain the eternal guidance given by the Lord. This guidance comes from the God who is free from the limitations of space and time as such as the principles of individual and social behaviour revealed by Him are base on reality. But God has revealed only broad principles and has endowed man with the freedom to apply them in every age in the way suited to the spirit and conditions of that age. It is through the Ijtihad that people of every age try to implement and apply divine guidance to the problems of their time.

#### ⑤ Complete record of teachings preserved

Another important feature of Islam is the fact that the teachings of Islam have been preserved in their original form. As a result, God's guidance is available

without adulteration of any kind. The Quran is the revealed book which has been in existence for the last 1450 years. It is still available in its original form.
