A - IMPACTS OF ALI-GARH MOVEMENT ON INDIAN POLITICS

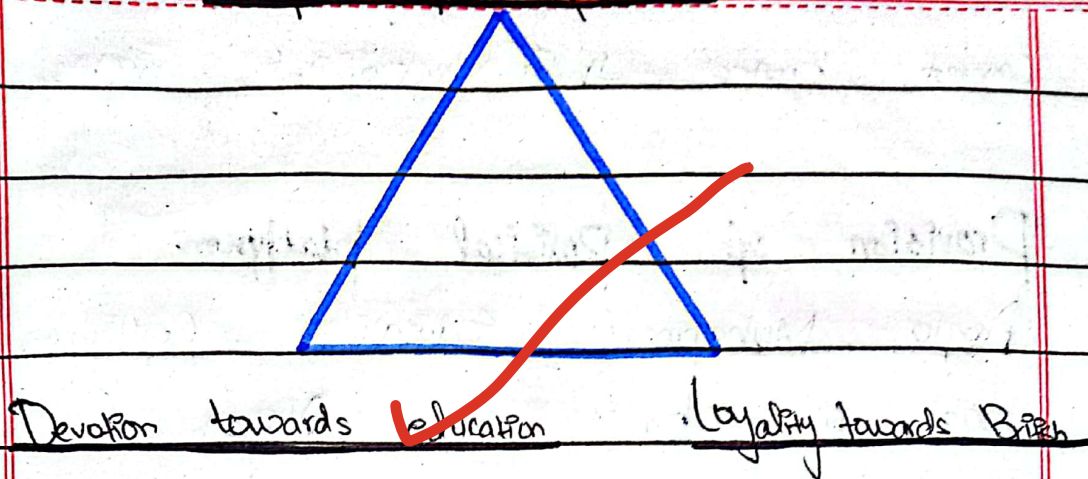
Involvement in politics after seeking political consciousness

During Aligarh Movement Sir Syed emphasized on seeking education. He imparted the getting the education. Muslims would be in a better position to demand their political rights through Constitutional means.

K. K. Aziz classified Aligarh Movement as trinity of idea

Alienation From Politics

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Sir Syed asked the Muslims to not join - the political party - Congress

Congress was dominated by Hindus primarily. In its first session out of 72 members only 2 were Muslims. It did not represent the Muslims of the Subcontinent truly.

Development of Political Consciousness

Due to the Aligarh Movement Muslims started seeking education through various institutes like MAO College. They realized that without education they

Provision of Political platform

Anglo Muhammad Educational Conferences

Muslims became aware that demands of separate electorate favours them most as compared to electoral system which Congress was demanding.

Created harmony between British and Muslims

Sir syed Ahmed Khan wrote Risala e Asbab e Baghawat e Hind to bridge the widening gap between British and Muslims.

Inclusion of Muslims in Legislative Council

Due to the efforts of Sir syed Ahmed Khan, Muslims were included in legislative Council. Syed Ameer Ali was the first Muslim who was elected to the Council.

Development of leadership

The graduates of Aligarh University (which was established in 1920) later initiated the Pakistan Movement and played vital role in the creation of Pakistan.

Protection of Urdu in Hindi-Urdu Controversy

The Hindi-Urdu Controversy started at Benares where Hindu wanted to replace Hindi as official language. Sir Syed advocated for Urdu language and later on it was developed as official language of Pakistan.

Awareness about political trends

In the world through Scientific Society

In 1857 Scientific Society was established to

translate the modern English literature
into Urdu, through which
people of India became aware
of the political rights and trends
in rest of the world.

Provision of roadmap for political struggle

Sir Syed provided the roadmap
to the Muslims of India
for politics. He urged Muslims
to be non-violent and to
equip themselves educationally.

Urged Muslims to bring efforts to get rid of British slavery

Sir Syed wrote a book
named **Abtal-e-Ghulami** to
awake the sense of
independence in Muslims of
India.

Alignment of politics with western democratic principles

Aligarh Movement inculcated a political sense in Muslims that Britishers are the torchbearer of democracy and liberal ideas. By following them they should also give independence to the people of Sub-Continent.
