Islamophobia and External Propaganda:

The other major challenge in today's time is the islamophobia and propaganda that leads to false image of Muslims.

Islamophobia caused when there is lack of knowledge or misconceptions about Islam.

Different media platforms promote Islamophobia by making Muslims stereotypes and old-school.

Many Hollywood and Bollywood movies are in propaganda against Muslim especially against Pakistan to portray a false sketch.

Anti-Islamic communities, Jews Community are also spreading Islamophobia and external propaganda to Muslims as in front of whole world.
