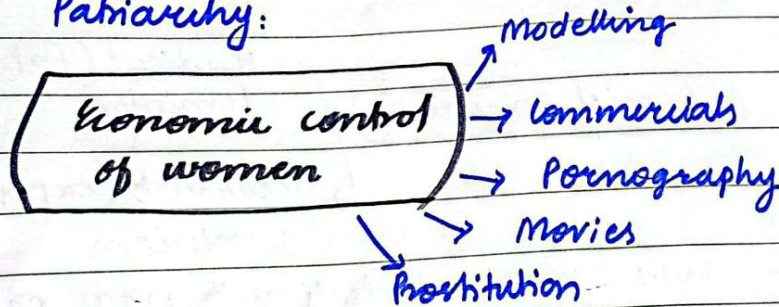

→ Through all these, men controls women by giving her money and women is subjugated.

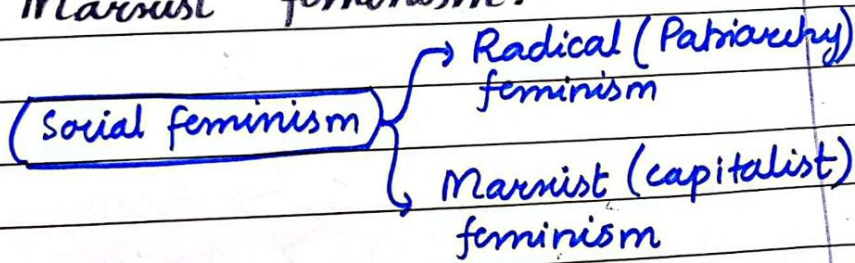
