Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah explains the importance of Pakistan in these words, "There is no power on Earth that can undo Pakistan." Pakistan is located in South Asia. It is a neighbour country of India, Afghanistan, Iran and China. Pakistan will survive because it has the unique characteristics to maintain its survival. It has potential to ensure her survival. Pakistan will survive as it has unique qualities such as geography, democracy, education, population, nationalism, religion, etc. that add to her survival. These qualities of Pakistan distinguish it from other countries of the world. It is need of the hour to implement some ways forwards, such as protect environment and use technology, to increase the survival of Pakistan. In this way, Pakistan can become a progressive nation.

Pakistan came into being on 14th August, 1947. Its founding father is Quaid-e-Azam. He said at the creation of Pakistan, "You are free; you are free to go to your temples. You are free to go to your mosques or to any other places of worship in this State of Pakistan. You may belong to any religion, caste or creed, that
