2) Justice is essential while distributing resources - economic equality.

Case in Point: NFC Awards and population of Balochistan issue.

3) Unless justice is served, social security is not achievable.

Case in Point: Natasha and Karsaz Incident Karachi (2014).

4) Merit-based selection process for jobs guarantees democratic values.

Case in Point: SPSC Biases.

5) Accountability of the ruler is mandatory for democracy to flourish.

Case in Point: Charter of Madina and Prophet SAW.

6) Equal applicability of rule of law on every citizen ensures democracy.

Case in Point: Elite cases (Hassan Nawaz) are disbursed in NAB, SC etc.

7) Violations of Human Rights fragment the true essence of democracy.

Case in Point: UNSC and veto power is an unjust, non-democratic practice.

8) Undue restriction on women rights are non-democratic.

Case in Point: Zia-ul-Haq's Ansari Commission.

9) Unequal representation in Parliament shatters democracy.

Case in Point: Sheikh Mujib's right to form Government was crushed.

10) Indifference towards minorities is autocratic.

Case in Point: Jaranwala Church Incident.

11) Difference in provision of education to children of the same state creates chaos.

Case in Point: Single National Curriculum and Madrassas issue leads to terrorism.

12. Unfair Imposition of sanctions by global organisations depict hegemonic aims.

Case in Point: Presslers' Amendment on Pakistan (1998). - Iran is sanctioned, Israeli is not.
