One who uses force lacks capabilities, knowledge and power of argument to prove his point of view for the passive settlement of disputes. The use of force for the sake of own interest is not a new concept rather it is running in the blood of history since Greek epochs and dark ages. Prophets, writers, gemalists, poets, masses, women, socialist activist, muslims, scientists have been victimized through the use of force. The weaker is crushed by the powerful to manifest its power and hegemony when ignorance and power blindfold them.

The person who uses force is afraid of logic and reason because he lacks the power of argument he lacks the knowledge, he lacks the rationality.

When someone is unable to prove his opinion and put a stance before others he uses force as his last choice. The use of force can be employed for the sake of power gain, establishing hegemony and for crushing the rising voices

Patriarchal society is the base of this power use. It is the witness of using power and force to deprive girls and women from their inherited rights. In our male-dominant society girls are black-mailed through emotional force to withdraw their property rights to their male siblings. However Islam gives the rights of property and inheritance to woman. Quran says "for men there is share unto they earn and for women there is a share unto they earn. Holy Prophet

Muhammad (P.B.U.H) assured the woman rights in his teachings. In this patriarchal society women are weak and are suppressed by domestic gender based violence. Women are protesting for their rights against male dominance and their protests are suppressed through force. **Aurat March** rally on 8th of March every year is indication of protest for equal rights for women. Pakistan reports every year **twenty thousand** gender-based violence cases according to police service Pakistan.

The voices which are raised to express their opinions and views about the state, government or any contemporary issue to aware the public are suppressed through use of physical force. The freedom of speech is the backbone

of democracy but unfortunately the freedom of speech is now crushed through force to hide the facts or refrain the public from awareness from the slumber of ignorance. **Voltaire** was a writer and philosopher who paid the value of freedom of speech. He awared people about the religious manipulation in Europe and his voice was suppressed through **assassination**. Another bold and blunt generalist **Arshad Sharif** was murdered in **Kenya** to suppress the dissenting voices and public opinion to hide the facts.

Not only generalists but also literary heroes have bore the brunt of force. History witnessed that any voice or action which provoked revolution

has been crushed through use of force. Habib Jalib was the renowned poet of Pakistan. In 1970s during the era of Ayub Khan - the military dictator, Habib Jalib wrote many poems to awaken the nation his most famous poem was "Dastoor" -

"Tery yeh zabtay mein nahi manta
mein nahi janta." (I do not
accept your rules and regulations).

He rejected the tailor-made one man constitution of 1962. He was prisoned in response to his rebellious poetry. Similarly the ignorant masses of India criticized the revolutionary poetry of Allama Muhammad Iqbal when he wrote poem "Shikwa".

The use of force is not a contemporary issue rather it has been existing since the inception of world. Not only general public but

but prophets had to face the tyrannical force of opponents. When prophets started preaching monotheism—oneness of God the ignorant people became their enemies and put them in hardships and forced them to leave Allah's way. When

Abraham (A.S) started preaching oneness of God, the then absolute power **Namrood** rejected his preaching, and put him in fire and said: "If your God exists He will save you." Namrood was afraid of reasoning and logic so he used force and put Abraham in fire.

The reasoning won and Allah saved Abraham (A.S) from fire.

Prophet Muhammad (P.B.D.H) was tortured when he announced prophecy, he had to face the hurdles and hardships of every kind. When prophet preached Allah in the city of **Taif** they bombarded you with stones so badly that

you started bleeding. The women of Makkah used to throw garbage on you, Quraisiites became hungry and thirsty for you. All these forms of force were used to stop you from the reasoning and logic provided by Allah.

Force is not only used individually or nationally but now a days it has become a trend to use any type of force to establish a hegemony in the region. There are many examples of regional use of force in our existing world where along with real war a cold war is also present. Some states are using force to maintain its hegemony over the region. India has been violating international human rights declaration in Kashmir since 1947. She is using force on naked

muslim Kashmiris just to show hegemony in the region specially to show lower side to Pakistan. Similar case is that of **Russia-Ukraine war**. Russia wants to establish and maintain hold over the eastern european countries while Europe and European union want to join Ukraine in **NATO and European union** so Russia attacked Ukraine to refrain it and Europe and NATO to get closer to Russia. **Vladimir Putin** clearly threatened European union and NATO that, "if anyone tried to get membered Ukraine in European union or NATO it will be handled iron-handedly." Russia has been using force in Ukraine to gain its geo-political interests.

Non-muslims and western countries are feared from muslims and consider Islam as a threat

to their existence, therefore they use force against muslims in the name of Islamophobia. The President of Sweden said; "Islam is the greatest threat for us after world war II." So they use force against muslim minorities present in western countries to put them under control. Christ-Church Massacre in March 2015 in Newzealand is the clear experimentation of use of force against muslims, where fifty one muslims were mass-amed in a mosque. Another most important manifestation of force comes from the Israel-palestine genocide. Since the establishment of jewish colony after Balford agreement, the innocent palestinian muslims have been victimized of force since decades. Israel and global powers are afraid of reasoning so suppressing palestinian by use of force.

Racial discrimination has been considered a societal ill and the so-called ambassadors of peace negates it but racial discrimination is still a major. In west, there was a huge difference between white and black races. The white race is considered as superior and Blacks are deprived off from their fundamental basic rights. A name **Martin Luther King** aroused, he was a socialist activists he instigated the **Civil Rights** moment for equality of all races. **Luther** said; "**I have a dream** when one day I wake up and see that my children are not being judged by race or color." He wrote a book — "**I have a Dream.**" Then he was prisoned and force silenced the voice of **Martin Luther** through racial force.

Nelson Mandela from South-Africa is another name of socialist activist who worked for the rights of Blacks. For this crime he was prisoned for **twenty seven** years and atleast reasoning won and he got elected as first Black president of South-Africa.

History is full of such illustrations in which force is intentionally used against logic and reason to suppress it. The weaker is suppressed by powerful, same is the case of ethnic cleansing and genocide to form an apartheid state in **Wanda-Africa** where thousands of minorities were killed for the sake of ethnic cleansing to establish an **apactheid** state.

British India also faced the force of Britisher. Britisher came in India for the sake of trade in the form of East-India company but they gradually took power over the whole sub-continent and they free handedly used force against Hindus and Muslims.

British Government passed Rowlet-Act and empowered police forces without any check and balance. That act aroused the sentiments of Hindus and muslims and they started protest throughout the whole country.

British government used force and that force use resulted in Jallianwala Bagh mass-aere.

And the peaceful protests became victim of force.

Louis Kings used to rule France in Eighteenth century.

There were three levels of public. The most elite level

was called elites, second level was named as nobles and third and lowest level masses were named as commoners. And the commoners had to pay about eighty to ninety percent tax as a whole. The commoners awakened from the sleep of slumber and started protests and raised slogans of equality, liberty and freedom. Louis King prisoned all the protestors and silenced their voices. These protests then resulted in French Revolution.

The use of force was also present in early ages when people started to think, reason and rationality established its routes. The prominent philosophers and thinkers belong to Greek epoch - Socrates, Aristotle, plato and Alexander the Great. Socrates is considered

as the pioneer of political science and philosophy, he enlightened the world with his revolutionary thinking. He criticized the democracy followed by city-states of Greece. For that he was imprisoned. His friend Crito offered him to escape from prison and to save his life. Socrates rejected his suggestion saying that if I would escape from prison then the liberty and freedom will lose and force would win. He was forced to drink poison. And political and philosophical innovations were tried to derail through assassination of Socrates, but his work continued through Plato and Xenophon.

Force has also been used against empirical truths in history. Catholic clergy prevailed the earth-centred

model of universe while Copernicus reversed this theory by presenting sun-centered theory of universe. The catholic clergy did not accepted this concept. Galileo wrote a book and ratified the copernicus concept of universe. The catholic clergy destroyed the empirical and experimental truth through use of force. They banned the book of galileo and put him in prisons where he died. So scientific knowledge was tried to suppress through use of force.

America was used to be a British colony before American revolution in 1776. Britishers imposed taxes on America to gain revenue but Americans got stood-up and raised slogans - "No taxation without representation." They demanded representation in British parliament and then applied force led to

Bowton - massacre.

Last but not the least is the religious manipulation of King and masses by Pop. Dark ages from 500 A.D to 1500 A.D was the era of Pop's magician.

Machiavelli a political English philosopher said; If King is a magician then there is another great magician - Pop. Machiavelli proposed the theory of separation of power. There should be no link between politics and religion. He said King manipulates the public and Pop manipulates the King. Pop makes King aware of the day and night and that the bread which he is eating is not a bread and wine he is drinking is not wine. So Pop and King both use force of manipulation to rule the ignorant masses.
