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### Question: What are the silent features of Islam

#### 1. **Belief in One God (Tawhid)**

- **Zakat:** Giving charity to help the needy. (Surah At-Tawbah, 9:103) (Surah Al-Maarij, 70:24-25)
- **Sawm:** Fasting during the month of Ramadan. (Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:183) (Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:187)
- **Hajj:** Performing the pilgrimage to Mecca if possible. (Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:196) (Surah Al-Hajj, 22:27)

#### 6. **Belief in the Afterlife (Akhirah)**

Muslims believe in life after death, where everyone will be judged by Allah for their actions and rewarded or punished in the afterlife. (Surah Al-Baqarah, 2:82)

#### 7. **Justice and Fairness**
