Woodrow Wilson is considered one of the pioneers of public administration in the United States. He believed that bureaucracy should function separately from the politicas to improve efficiency in government. In his essay" The Stud of Administration" (1887), Wilson argued that public administration needed to become a professional field guided merit and expertise rather than politica influence. His main focus was on reforming government institutions to better serve the & need of citizens and created more responsive democratic system. Max Weber's Thoughts on Bureau cracy: Max weber, a German Sociologist, pro vide of a more theoretical and comparative analycis of bureaucracy. He described bureaucracy as an ideal system type" of administrative organization character ized by Clear hierarchy, special led role



DELAC Day: and governance based on written rules and procedures Weber believed that bureaucra cy is was essential for modern societies because it allowed governments to function rationally and efficiently, mininizing personal blas and ensuring decisions were made impartially. 4. Similarities between Wilson and Weber on Bureaucracy 1- Hierarchy and Structured Organi Zation: Wilson and weber recognized the importance of hierarchical structuses in bureaucracy. They believed that a clear chaim of command and division of responsibilities would enchance accountability and ensure that tasks were carried out effeciently at different level of administration. This & structured approach aimed to avoid confusion and overlapping duties within govern ment institutions.



Separation of Politics and 2. Administration: Wilson and Meber agreed that politics (policy-making) should be separate from administration (implementation policies). This wasto prevent corrupt tion and esure that decisions were made based on nues rather than personal interests. Rational Organization: 3-Both thinkers highlighted the need for rationality in administration. They believed that bureaucracy should operate through a system of rules, hierarchy, and specialized holes. Emphasis on Efficiency: 4-Both Wilson and We er believed that bure and racy was necessary to ensure the smooth and efficient functioning of government. They thought that organized structures and clear rules could improve public administration.



5- Impersonal and Objective Decision-Making: Both thinkers believed that bureaucracies should operate without personal bals. They emphasized that decisions should be made based on established rules and objective criteria rather than individual preferences or political commetions.
