→ Sir Robert (British)

→ August Villmer (America)

Both modified the techniques of investigation in their countries after urbanization.

Hans Gross definition:

Scientific inquiry into the commission of crime step by step.

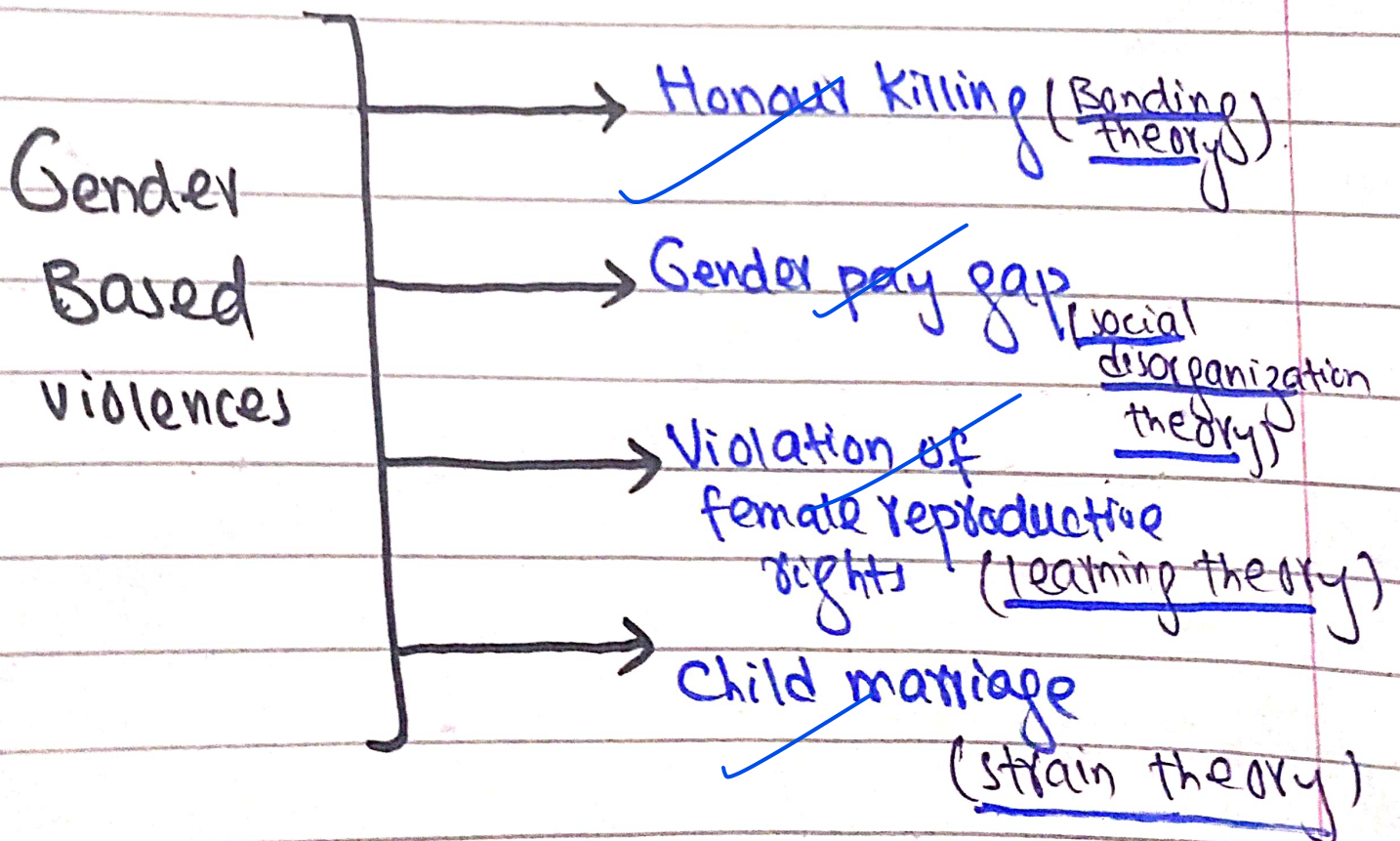
Objective of Investigation:

- to detect the nature of crime
- to find the offender
- to save the physical evidence
- to recover the stolen property.

What are gender based violence:

The violence mainly taken against the marginalized group of the society, including women, children, transgender, etc. ✓

Types of gender-based violence:



Status of Pakistan in Gender-based violence:

→ Justice index: 126th/150 countries

→ Women empowerment
in politics index: 95th rank

Legal and Ethical guidelines for investigating gender based crimes:

(i)

→ Fair and free justice and investigation.

A fair and free trial is the basic
right of oppressed. Hence, the
first guideline is to provide fair
justice and investigation.

(ii)

→ Protection of the gender against the offender:

Sometimes the offender belongs to a rich family. Hence, the evidence from the crime scenes are removed. Additionally, they force the victim family to draw their case. Hence, the second guideline is to provide shelter during investigation.

(iii)

→ Protection of the victims identity:

Protection of the victims identity is very fundamental guideline, before proceeding investigation. Because victim should rehabilitate and should incorporate in society after justice.

(iv)

→ Giving legal and medical aid to the victim:

The legal and medical are also an essential fundamental of ethical guideline. As there are some instances, where due to lack of legal knowledge and lack of health facilities, the oppressed feel a lot of problems.

Example: Sindh, Balochistan and ARQ

(v)

→ During investigation the rights of the eye witness should be protected:

In under developing nations, the eye witness mainly face a lot

of pressure from the outsiders. Hence, mainly, people avoid to part of investigation process. Due to such behaviour the gender based cases remain unsolved. Hence, during and after investigation the protection of eye witness should be considered in ethical guidelines

(vi)

→ Presenting the recovered evidence from the crime location should present in court with honesty and integrity:

A plethora of instances observed, where the recovered evidences are replaced during court process, resulting in unfair decision. Hence, the ethical guideline is that investigating officer evaluate all the evidence before presenting in court.
