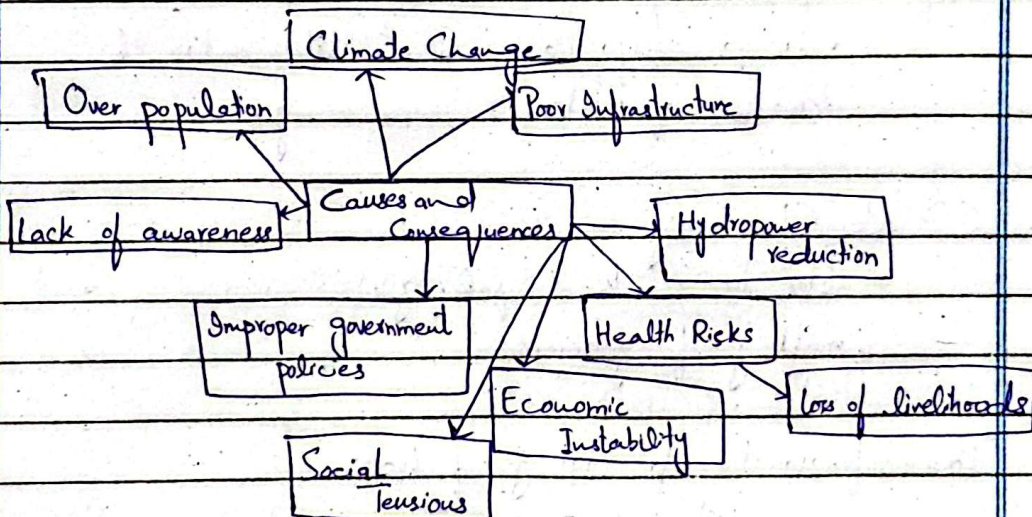

 - government lack proper dams and storage for water.
