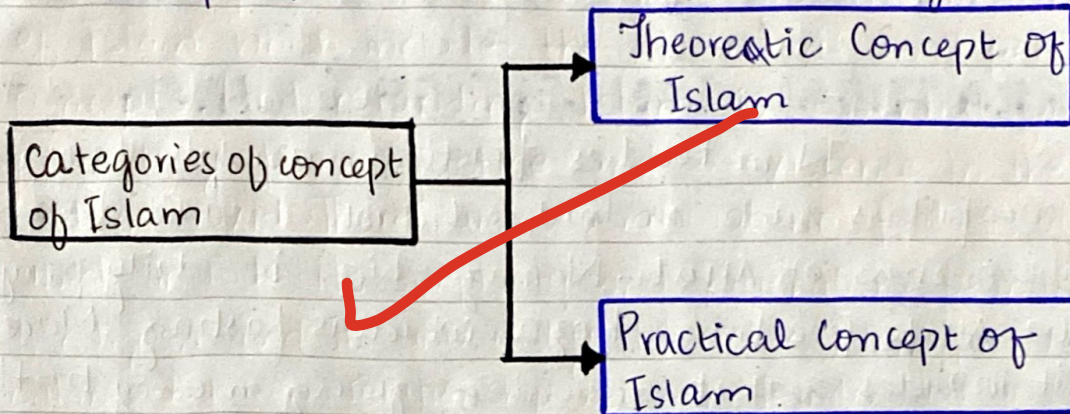
3. IMPORTANCE OF UNDERSTANDING ISLAM IN THE MODERN WORLD:

Allah has sent revelations for guidance of mankind.

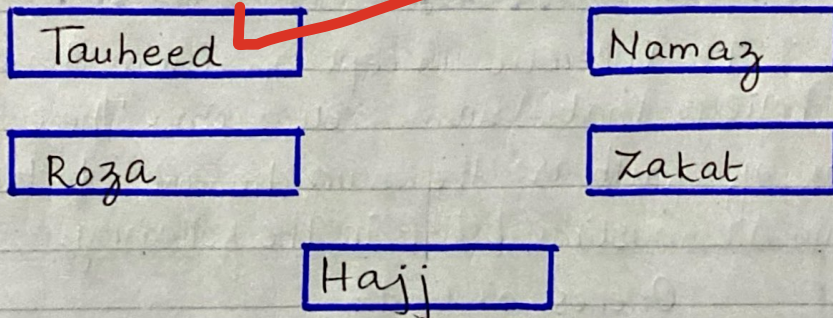
Resurrection of death and day of judgement.
