The two chief prohibitions of this act are: firstly, creating a criminal offence for 'fake' and 'false' information (non-bailable); secondly, prohibiting contents that casts 'aspersions' against members of the state.

The Peca Act is by executive, the very organ that executes the laws. Peca Act 2025 is for the protection of both the people and the state.

This Act has restrainede disinformation. After the deployment of surveillance technology, state has to protect its narrative.

Therefore, information is protected to maintain balance in the Democratic Pakistan. The open consultation is necessary from the people for the greater public interest. All laws allows ~~the~~ their citizens to protect their free expression without breeding disinformation. The Peca Act also fullfills this criteria to ensure information protection in the democratic Society.
