mujahideen on Pakistan's soil.
Zia's Islamization further favored the
situation and as a result Pakistan
became the epicenter of global
Jihad against 'red armies'.

in the tribal areas, as a result,
the local tribal lords started
struggle against the state itself
because of the deprivation
they was facing.

(iii) Shelter to refugees and economic marginalisation.

Pakistan give space to almost 4-milllion refugees from afghans. It increased the economic burden on Pakistan. Also, among these refugees were some 'criminals'. These non-state actor acts as a proxy of India.

(iv) 9/11 and the emergence of Al-Qaeda, ISIS and TTP.

After 9/11, the american President J. Bush forced Pakistan to help american in its great war on terror. Pakistan, again joined the western bloc. As a result, the taliban and other militant group, which previously had soft image for Pakistan, became the enemy of Pakistan. This strategic mistake of Pakistan resulted into decade of internal instability, economic breakdown and Political

- (v) Drone attacks: turning nationalist struggles into Anti-State armed movements

After 9/11 attacks, Pakistan again became a strong ally of America for 'wrong reasons'. Because of this alignment Pakistan had to compromise on its territorial sovereignty. 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(vi) Role of External actors :
