The essence of "moral equivalence" remains questionable in the face of war. Since the bottomline for states remains security, they don't take into account the moral factor while pursuing their objectives. As war has no moral justification, moral equivalence doesn't hold any ground.

c)

The countries occupied by hyperpower are subjected to the dissent from people who deem it threat to their identities. Consequently, the country descends into chaos and feuds. This provides an opportunity to warlords to establish their authority at the expense of local people. Hence, peace cannot prevail in such societies.

d).
