There are multitudes of factors which have aggravated Balochistan insurgency, but the most cogent and convincing is ^{depriving of} socio-economic developments in the province. Balochistan having 43% of Pakistan's total land area and 7-8% of total population, the region is deprived of basic necessities and infrastructure facilities. Despite gas coming from the People of Balochistan do not have primary schools, hospitals and road networks. Deprived people are forced to travel province capital, Quetta, to acquire their basic needs. So much so that local people do not have gas connections in their houses. By 1960, Karachi, Lahore, Rawalpindi and other cities received the gas pipeline. Unfortunately, Sui residence still do not have access of the gas. Government arguing that due to province scattered population, the cost of pipeline is bigger than the number of beneficiaries. Moreover, from 1996 to 2012, the province had only 2% of share from Sindh coal ^{mine} ~~cop~~ which is increased to 6.5% in 2023. This shows a region undated besiege of natural resource is getting merely share, then how will 43% of area will be developed? and how socio-economic development can occur which can facilitate the local by providing job opportunities, health facilities, schools and road networks. Therefore, depriving Balochistan of socio-economic developments to some ^{extend} ~~extent~~ is responsible for rise in insurgency in Balochistan.
