Areeba: Then perhaps, we should draft a formal email explaining the issue and proposing a revised timeline.

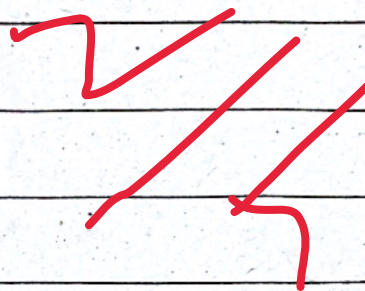
Hamza: That sounds reasonable. Should I include the technical glitches as part of explanation?
