The life of Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) is a true example of mercy and kindness not only for his believers but for his enemies and animals too. In Quran, Allah stated:

وما ارسلناك الا رحمة للعالمين ؕ

" We have sent you 'O Prophet' as a mercy for whole world

During the event of conquer of Makkah, the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) not only forgave his enemies but also declared that whoever takes refuge in the house of Abu Sufiyan (R.A) (his ex-enemy) will be safe from chaos. Once Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) was travelling with His companions when the camel of one of his companion looked tired and thirsty to him. fair in all his affairs. He abolished all the laws of biasness and nepotism. Before his first revelation, he was known as '**Sadiq**' and '**Amin**' among the people of Makkah. When a women from tribe banu-makhzoom stole something and people were confused whether to punish her or not, the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) strictly condemned this and said,

'If my daughter Fatima was to steal something, I would have asked to cut off her hands'

This stresses that how Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) inspires an individual to abide by the rule of Allah and islamic law in all his social affairs.

- Staunch proponent of women rights and women empowerment

Another significant aspect of his life is that Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) has

always stressed about the protection of human rights but all above women.

During khutba-Hujjat-ul-wida, he narrated,

'And fear Allah in the matters of women'

He provided a right of dignity and liberty to women of Arab who were used to be buried alive before the advent of Islam. He broke the laws of useless traditions and the most significant example set by the Holy Prophet (P.B.U.H) is that He married a business woman Hazrat Khadija (R.A) on her own proposal who was twice of His age. This breaks all the false social norms regarding women in the present world. He was a perfect son, perfect husband and perfect father and thus guides an individual to follow his footsteps to live a rightful life.
