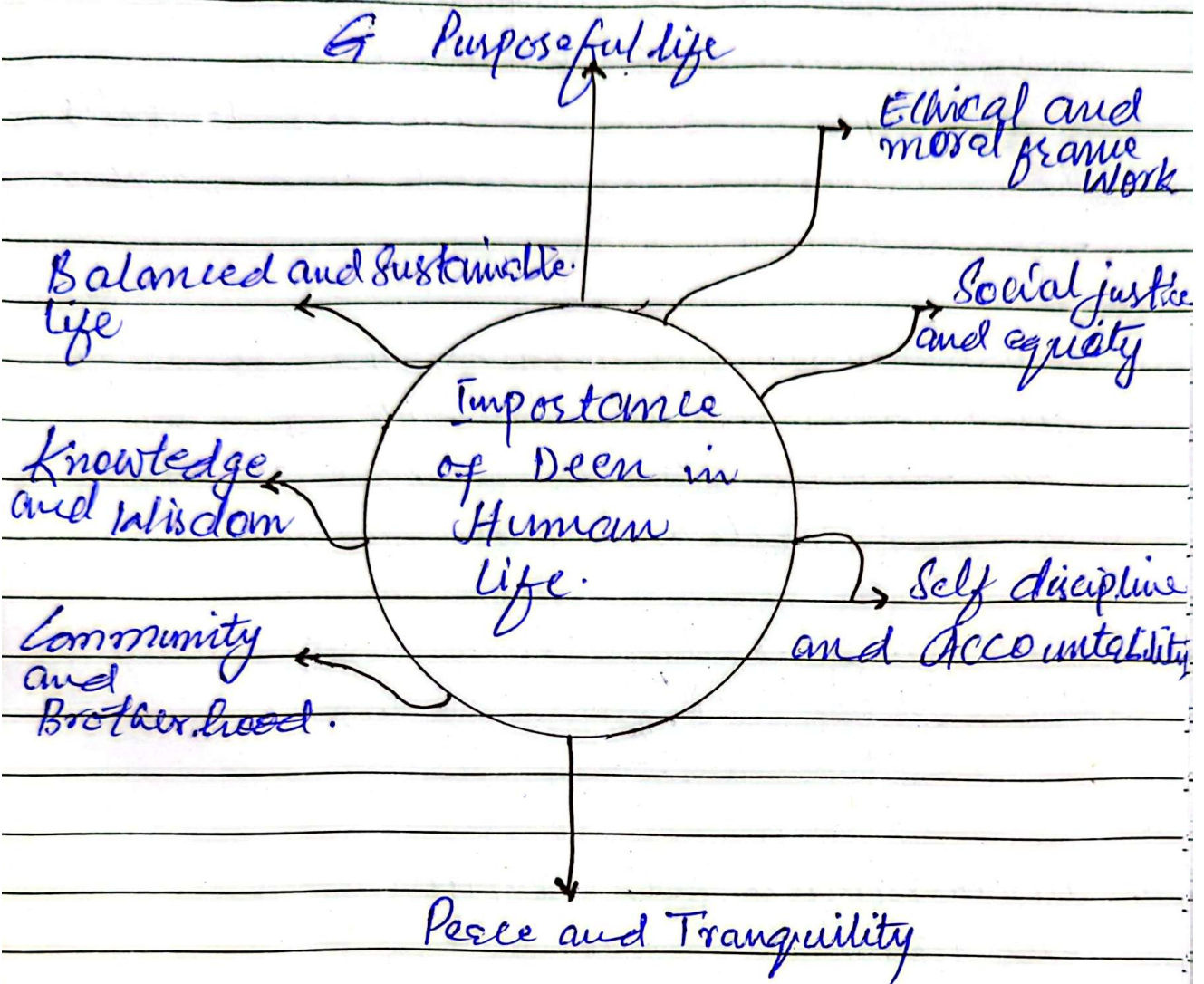
B- Importance of Deen in Human life-
