As per Economic Survey of Pakistan (2024-25) Pakistan has a low literacy rate about 58-60%. Meanwhile, other South Asian countries like Sri Lanka has a ~~92%~~

highest literacy rate in a region. Nepal and Butan have 77% literacy rate in a region. On the other hands, low quality of education in Pakistan is impacting country's future. Unqualified teachers and outdated curriculum with less focus on science and technology is a challenge for quality-based education. For instance

India's education system is highly focused towards IT sector (Information and technology sector) as a result India has well trained IT professionals dispoise which is leading world IT sector. However, Government of Pakistan has no enough contribution for education. In fiscal year budget (2026-27) only 2% GDP has been contributed for educational purposes. Due to

Moreover, to overcome these challenges government should allocate high budget for education, curriculum and assessment reform should be taken.
