i. A PERFECT ROLE MODEL:

ii. A MAN OF NOBLE CHARACTER:

The Holy Prophet (PBUH) was a man of noble character. Every teachings of Islam like mercy, forgiveness, patience etc were reflected in his character. Even, in Quran Allah has said;

“And Indeed, you (O Muhammad) are of great moral character.”

iii. AN IDEAL FAMILY MAN:

The Holy Prophet (PBUH) ^{is} ~~was~~ an ideal family man. He used to do household chores. Apart from this, he used to mend his own clothes. He has always showed affection to his wives and maintained harmony. There is a Hadith;

“The best of you are those who are best to their wives.”

iv. SOCIAL JUSTICE AND LEADERSHIP

The Holy Prophet was not a just a preacher, he was a great leader too. He has always prioritized social justice. He built the state of Madinah - considered as an ideal state. In state of Madinah, minorities were protected, poor were being helped, and there was justice for all. Allah Orders in Quran;

"But, if you judge, judge b/w them justly. Allah loves the just."

v. FORGIVENESS AND MERCY: TAUGHT THROUGH ACTIONS

The Holy Prophet (SAW) was a man of great patience and tolerance. He had been mocked and got treated too harshly, but he tolerated all that. He could take revenge from all those, but he preferred ~~venge~~ forgiveness over vengeance. He forgave everyone

at Conquest of Makkah. Earlier, when he was stoned in Taif, On Jibrael's suggestion, he said;

"Perhaps, their children will worship Allah."

vi. LED BY EXAMPLE IN SIMPLICITY AND HUMILITY

The Holy Prophet (SAW) has the highest status among all the humans on this earth, yet he preferred to live a simple life. He has never been arrogant. He treated everyone with love and kindness. He used to sit on floor. Once he said;

"I eat as a servant eats, and I sit as a servant sits." ~ (Al-Hadith)

vii. TREATED SLAVES, WOMEN, AND CHILDREN WITH RESPECT:

The Holy Prophet (SAW) used to treat everyone with respect. He had always shown kindness towards slaves and loved children. He used

Kiss Hassan & Hussain (RA). He used to stand up for Fatima (RA).
