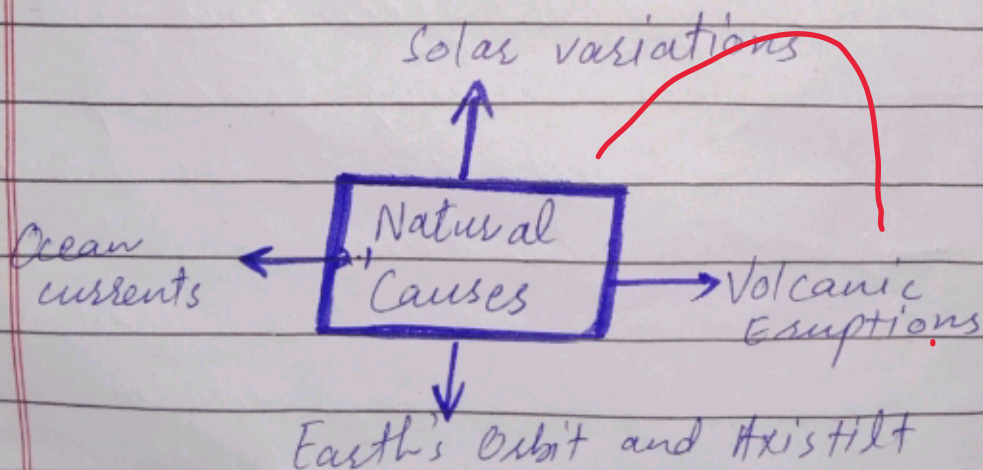

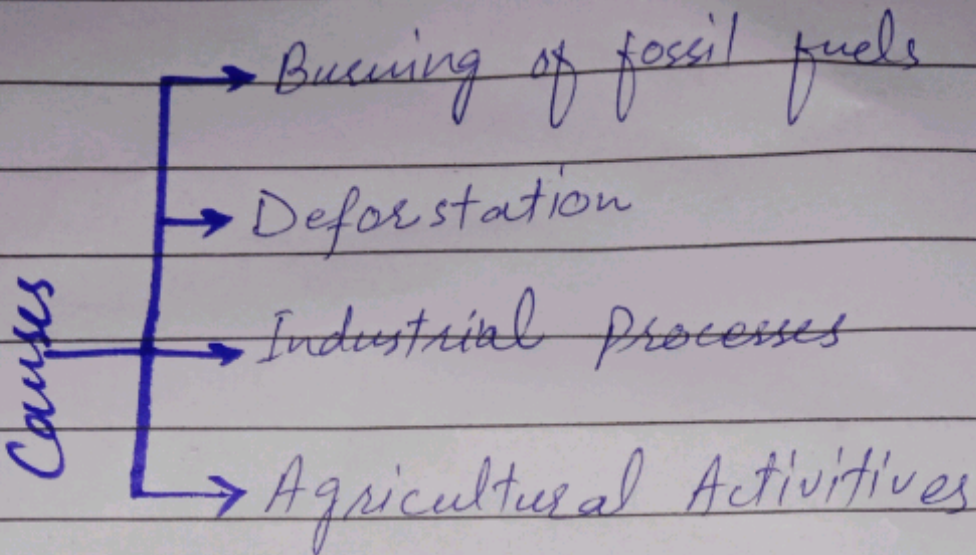
1.3. Thesis statement:
