Islam has guaranteed many human rights, five of them are ① Right to life and security ② Right to freedom and religion & beliefs ③ Right to justice and equality ④ Right to property and wealth ⑤ Right to dignity & honour. Quran and Sunnah emphasize these rights.

① Right to life and security

Islam considers human life sacred & prohibits unjust killing.

"Whoever kills a person - unless in retribution for murder or spreading corruption in the land - it is as if he has killed all of humanity" (5:32)

The prophet (ﷺ) emphasized the importance of life and security at the Farewell sermon.

② Right to Freedom of Religion & Belief

Islam upholds religious freedom and prohibits coercion in matters of faith.

"There is no compulsion in religion. The right path has become distinct from the wrong path".

(2:256)

### (3) Right to Justice & Equality

Justice is fundamental pillar of Islamic teachings.

"Indeed, Allah commands you to render trusts to whom they are due and when you judge between people to judge with justice" (4:58)

### (4) Right to Property and Wealth

Islam guarantees individuals the right to own and manage their wealth lawfully.

"Do not consume one another's wealth unjustly or send it (in bribery) to the rulers in order to (illegally) consume a portion of others' wealth lawfully and sinfully" (2:188)

### (5) Right to dignity and honour

Every human being is honoured in Islam, regardless of race, ethnicity, or status.

"And we have certainly honoured the children of Adam" (17:70)
